Subject: Comments Regarding Energy Efficiency and Distributed Energy Resource (DER)

Why DER should be recognized and incorporated as a component of energy efficiency.

KCC is considering authorizing utility-proposed rate increases to recover costs associated with improving energy efficiency to conserve resources and reduce pollutants. Just as energy efficiency improvements reduce use of finite polluting resources like fossil fuels and nuclear, wind and solar (DER) provide the same environmental gains. In the recent past, KCC has considered recommendations from utilities to assess special punitive rates for home/business solar arrays and wind generators. Investments in DER reflect individual consumer dedication to clean energy. DER serves as a free-market, viable, growing component to be utilized along with improved conservation and energy efficiency to reduce pollution and use of finite resources. Consumer-based DER should not be ignored by KCC. *The purpose of this letter is to urge the Commission to take no actions which would impede increased investment by individuals or businesses in distributed wind or solar distributed energy resources (DER).*

Recommended guiding principles to foster expanded DER.

I (Wentz) support the Brombright principles as listed on page 11 of the "Initial comments of Mr. Bradley D. Lutz, dated 16 Feb 2017, regarding DER customers." These are repeated below:

- *A customer should be able to connect to the grid for no more than the cost of connecting to the grid.*

- *Customers should pay for grid services and power supply in proportion to how much (and when) they use these services and how much power they consume.*
- *Customers who supply power to the grid should be fairly compensated for the full value of the power they supply, no more nor no less.*
- *Tariffs should fairly balance the interests of all stakeholders: the utility, the non-DER customer, and the DER customer.*

Further comments.

Wind and solar energy are the clean, sustainable energy sources of the future. Zero water use, zero mining, zero fuel transport, zero toxic waste, zero CO2 and other emissions are attributes essential to meeting the energy needs for a world of 9 billion inhabitants by 2050.

The monopoly status of utilities as sole generators of electricity can no longer be justified. For more than a century, electric utilities have enjoyed monopoly status, essential to avoid duplication of distribution lines and services. Advances in wind turbine technologies, coupled with increasing recognition of resource limitations and environmental concerns have led to adoption of wind farms, augmenting and gradually replacing large central fossil and nuclear fuel systems. Westar reports that one-third of their energy will be produced by wind before the end of 2017. Rapid advances in photo-voltaic (PV) solar cell technologies and electronic control systems, with corresponding reductions in cost are making PV generating competitive with older fossil fuel and nuclear energy sources. An increasing number of home and business owners are investing their own resources in solar PV, often installed on available rooftop space. *Utilities should accommodate these systems without punitive penalties. KCC should not adopt policies that unfairly inhibit DER, including individual rooftop solar.*

Solar PV is not disruptive to utility grid operations. I can attest that the University United Methodist Church, Wichita array has been in operation for 23 months, without disrupting Westar service. Our system was one of 15 projects funded by grants from Westar. Our system, rated at 10 kW, has provided 17% of our church needs, with 3% excess solar generation going back to other Westar customers and credited to our bill via present net metering policy. The change in power when a passing cloud shades our array is equivalent to one of our eight air-conditioning units switching on-line. Our own detailed engineering studies conducted by myself and WSU engineering faculty and students, show that load variations are no different in magnitude or pulse duration than operations prior to solar array installation. Our experience mirrors the data shown in the Lutz report above.

Westar will bring its own "Community Solar" PV system on line within a few months. This is clear evidence that PV is not disruptive to utility-connected operation. *Any reduction or change in net metering policy or added charges for non-utility generation (DER) should be approved by KCC only if the utilities can demonstrate that such charges are justified by actual experience.*
