**ORDER APPROVING MODIFICATION TO INTERCONNECTION
AGREEMENT BETWEEN AT&T AND MCC TELEPHONY**

The above-captioned matter comes on before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission approves the Application of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Kansas (AT&T) for Approval of Modification of Interconnection Agreement (ICA) between AT&T and MCC Telephony of the Midwest, LLC (MCC Telephony) (Application).

1. AT&T filed its Application on March 9, 2011.
2. Commission staff (Staff) provided its Report and Recommendation (Report) on May 31, 2011, analyzing the Application. Staff's Report was posted on the Commission's website on June 1, 2011, to afford interested persons an opportunity to comment on the Application. No public comments were received.
3. In its Report, Staff explained that MCC Telephony is the nation's seventh largest cable television company among the leading cable operators which focus on serving the smaller cities and town in the United States.

4. Both AT&T and MCC Telephony are duly registered with the Kansas Secretary of State's office and are "active and in good standing" with that office.

5. The Commission approved the underlying ICA between AT&T and MCC Telephone on May 4, 2010.

6. Staff advised the Commission that the modification to the AT&T/MCC Telephony ICA adds MCC Telephony's certification that it will operate under, and submit its orders with, the Carrier Identification Code (CIC) code of 5086, issued by the North American Numbering Plan Administration to MCC Telephony's parent company.

7. Staff further advised that AT&T maintained that implementation of the modification of its ICA with MCC Telephony fully complied with the Telecommunications Act of 1996 and that the ICA modification was consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and, in addition, did not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier.

8. Staff recommended Commission approval of AT&T's Application.

9. The Commission has reviewed Staff's Report and concludes that it should approve AT&T's Application.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:


