

**MOTION TO CANCEL PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND CLOSE DOCKET**

On December 19, 2016, Staff filed a motion requesting that an order to show cause be issued against Operator, based upon Commission records indicating that an unplugged well remained on Operator's expired license. On March 7, 2017, the Commission issued an order to show cause, setting an April 6, 2017, prehearing conference.

Staff reports that the well in question has recently been transferred to an active license. Since the compliance issue has been resolved, Staff asks that the prehearing conference be cancelled and that the docket be closed.

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
