RE: ABERCROMBIE ENERGY, LLC. - Application for a permit to authorize the injection of saltwater into the Venus-Brown No. 1-26, located in Seward County, Kansas.

To: All oil and Gas Producers, Unleased Mineral Interest Owners, Landowners, and all persons whomever concerned.

You, and each of you, are hereby notified that Abercrombie Energy, LLC has filed an application to commence the injection of saltwater into the Mississippi formation at the Venus-Brown No. 1-26, located in the NW-SE-NE Section 26-T33S-R31W, Seward County, Kansas, with a maximum operating pressure of 1500 psig and maximum injection rate of 1750 barrels saltwater per day.
