MOTION FOR PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff and Commission, respectively), moves the Commission for a Proposed Default Order to be issued against the Operator. In support of its motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. On March 16, 2021, the Commission issued a Penalty Order against Operator in the captioned docket.¹
 - 2. On April 16, 2021, Operator filed a Request for Hearing.²
- 3. On May 7, 2020, the Commission issued its Order Designating Presiding Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference in this docket and set a Prehearing Conference for May 13, 2021.³ The Commission Order provides that any party that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the KAPA.⁴
- 4. On May 13, 2021, Operator failed to attend the prehearing conference. Staff believes Operator was properly noticed and afforded sufficient opportunity to attend the May 13, 2021, prehearing conference, but failed to do so. Therefore, Staff requests that a proposed default order be issued against Operator.
