PENALTY ORDER

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The Commission finds Operator has violated K.S.A. 55-172 and K.A.R. 82-3-603(e) regarding the captioned tank battery, assesses a \$5,000 penalty, directs Operator to come into compliance, and further rules as more fully described below.

I. JURISDICTION

K.S.A. 74-623 provides that the Commission has the exclusive jurisdiction and 1. authority to regulate oil and gas activities. K.S.A. 55-152 provides that the Commission has jurisdiction to regulate the construction, operation, and abandonment of any well and the protection of the usable water of this state from any actual or potential pollution from any well. The Commission has licensing authority pursuant to K.S.A. 55-155.

2. K.S.A. 55-162 and K.S.A. 55-164 provide the Commission with authority to issue a Penalty Order regarding a violation of Chapter 55 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, or of any rule, regulation, or order of the Commission. A Penalty Order may include a monetary penalty of up to \$10,000, and each day of a continuing violation constitutes a separate violation.

3. K.S.A. 55-172 provides it shall be unlawful for any person having possession or control of any well drilled for oil or gas to permit salt water, oil or refuse from any such well to escape by overflow, seepage or otherwise from the vicinity of such well, and that it shall be the

duty of any such person to keep such salt water, oil or refuse safely confined in tanks, pipelines or ponds, so as to prevent the escape thereof.

4. K.A.R. 82-3-101(a)(69) defines "spill" as any escape of saltwater, oil, or refuse by overflow, seepage, or other means from the vicinity of oil, gas, injection, service, or gas storage wells, or from tanks, pipelines, dikes, or pits, if the wells, tanks, pipelines, dikes, or pits are involved in or related the exploration or drilling for oil or gas; the lease storage, treatment, or gathering of oil or gas; or the drilling, operating, abandonment, or post-abandonment of wells. For purposes of this regulation, "vicinity" means the area within six feet of the wellhead.

5. K.A.R. 82-3-603(a) provides that each operator shall act with reasonable diligence to prevent spills and safely confine saltwater, oil and refuse in tanks, pipelines, pits, or dikes.

6. K.A.R. 82-3-603(e) provides that each operator shall clean up any spill that requires notification within 10 days after discovery or knowledge, or by the deadline prescribed in writing by the district office, and that each operator shall clean up any spill that does not require notification upon completion of the routine operation or condition that caused the leak, drip, or escape, or within 24 hours of discovery or knowledge, whichever occurs sooner.

7. K.A.R. 82-3-603(f) provides that failure to contain and clean up the spill in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-603 shall be punishable by the following penalties: \$1,000 for the first violation; \$2,500 for the second violation; and \$5,000 and an operator license review for the third violation.

II. FINDINGS OF FACT

8. Operator is licensed to conduct oil and gas activities in Kansas under license number 5556, and is responsible for the care and control of the North Campbell Tank Battery located in Section 36, Township 27 South, Range 16 East, Wilson County, Kansas.

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9. On March 15, 2021, Commission District #3 Staff contacted Operator regarding a spill at its North Campbell Tank Battery (Subject Tank Battery). The spill extended beyond lease boundaries and reached surface water. Staff informed Operator that because the spill exited the lease and reached surface water, Operator was obligated to contact the Kansas Department of Health and Environment and the National Response Center.¹

10. On March 23, 2021, Commission District #3 Staff inspected the Subject Tank Battery and found Operator had failed to clean up the spill.² On March 24, 2021, Staff sent a Notice of Violation letter to Operator.³ The letter gave Operator until April 5, 2021, to complete cleanup of the spill at the Subject Tank Battery.⁴ On April 12, 2021, Commission District #3 Staff reinspected the Subject Tank Battery and found Operator had still failed to clean up the spill at the Subject Tank Battery.⁵

11. To any extent the Subject Tank Battery exhibits continuing leaks, the Commission finds environmental damage may result if immediate remedial action is not taken.

III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Commission has jurisdiction over Operator and this matter under K.S.A. 55 152 and K.S.A. 74-623.

13. The above findings of fact are sufficient evidence to support the conclusion that Operator committed one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-603(e) because Operator failed to clean up the spill at the Subject Lease in a timely manner.

14. Based upon similar violations Operator previously received in Dockets 20-CONS-3182-CPEN and 21-CONS-3053-CPEN, the Commission concludes Operator should be assessed a third violation under K.A.R. 82-3-603(f). Under K.A.R. 82-3-603(f), a third violation carries a \$5,000 penalty and an operator license review. Alternatively, the Commission concludes Operator's violation of K.S.A. 55-172 merits the same outcome as described within this paragraph.

15. The Commission concludes that it should authorize Commission District #3 Staff to take any remedial action necessary to stop continuing leaks at the Subject Tank Battery.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. Operator shall pay a \$5,000 penalty.

B. Operator shall take immediate remedial action to prevent future spills at the North Campbell tank battery to the satisfaction of Commission District #3 Staff. If Operator fails to comply, then Staff may take any action necessary to prevent continuing leaks at the North Campbell tank battery, regardless of whether Operator requests a hearing on this Penalty Order, and shall assess such costs to Operator. If Operator requests a hearing on this Penalty Order, then Staff shall notify the Commission of any costs assessed to prevent leaks from the tank battery, by filing the invoice(s) in this docket.

C. Operator shall fully remediate the spill within 30 days. If Operator fails to comply, then Staff may remediate the spill and assess the costs to Operator.

D. Operator may request a hearing on the above issues by submitting a written request, pursuant to K.S.A. 55-164, K.S.A. 77-537, and K.S.A. 77-542, to the Commission at 266 N. Main St., Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202, within 30 days from the date of service of this Order. <u>A request for hearing must comply with K.A.R. 82-1-219.</u>

E. Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of Operator's right to a hearing. If no party timely requests a hearing, then this Order shall become final. If Operator is not

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in compliance with this Order and the Order is final, then Operator's license shall be suspended without further notice and shall remain suspended until Operator complies. The notice and opportunity for a hearing on this Order shall constitute the notice required by K.S.A. 77-512 regarding license suspension. A party may petition for reconsideration of a final order pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).

F. Credit card payments may be made by calling the Conservation Division at 316-337-6200. Checks and money orders shall be payable to the Kansas Corporation Commission. Payments shall be mailed to the Kansas Corporation Commission at 266 N. Main St., Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202. Payments must reference the docket number of this proceeding.

Problem:

Operator had a spill that appears to have started at the North Campbell tank battery. The spill got off lease and on water.

Persons contacted:

Operator Robert Bukaty (913)-620-1881 and KCC staff

Findings:

Operator had a spill at the North Campbell tank battery 36-27-16E WL. Co. The spill entered the county road ditch and traveled approximately 350 feet north along the east ditch. The spill then turned east and traveled approximately 380. The first roughly 230 feet is grass that is oil stained. The last 150 feet of the spill is over pooled water that has 3 small pools of oil in it. This area is roughly 6 inches wide. The oil also crossed under the county road via culverts and entered a small pool. The pond is roughly 40 feet north to south and 180 feet east to west. There is oil soaked vegetation in the pond and rainbows of oil along parts of the edges. At the tank battery the spill crossed the road and entered the west ditch and traveled roughly 160 feet north and was less than a foot wide. 16 photos were taken while on location and multiple points were referenced with GPS to help outline the spill area.

Problem:

Operator had a spill on 3/15/2021 that left the lease and got onto water.

Persons contacted:

KCC Staff

Findings:

I returned on 3/23/2021 and found that the operator had not yet started cleanup on spill # 28425. The area where the oil had traveled east away from the county road had actually impacted a large area. This was due to not be addressed when the operator had a chance before a heavy rain. The rain caused the oil to spread staining more grass immediately after it turned east. As the spill traveled east the impacted area was roughly the same as before to the end of the spill area. My investigation also found that the oil that was pooled in the pond had stained the vegetation within the pond. I could no longer see pooled oil on the pond but there was an oil sheen or rainbow present in a few locations. This had extended to the west end of the pond were oil was not present on my initial investigation. While on location I found that recent rain had caused the oil that was in the west ditch to turn west and exit the ditch. This fluid traveled approximately 260 feet west and was roughly two foot wide at the widest. This was a low lying area that was covered in scrub brush. I have attached the twelve photos that were taken while on location and I have attached a google map that shows the impacted area on 3/23/2021.

Re: Spill cleanup on the North Campbell lease located in Section 36, Township 27 South, Range 16 East, Wilson County.

Mr. Bukaty,

This letter is to document our phone conversation on March 15, 2021 concerning a spill on the above mentioned North Campbell lease. I told you that you had 24 hours to report the spill to the District #3 Office and that you had 24 hours to stop the source of the spillage, contain the spillage and to begin clean up on the spillage. I also told you that you would be required to contact KDHE at 1-785-291-3333 because the oil spillage got off the lease and the National Response Center at 1-800-424-8802 to report that the spillage got on water.

You told me that you would contact someone to clean up the spillage and that you would contact me to let me know who would be doing the cleanup so they could coordinate the cleanup with me. I have not heard from you since our conversation on March 15, 2021 and I inspected the spill area yesterday on March 23, 2021 and I did not see that any cleanup has occurred. The oil escaped the berm area at the tank battery and the on-going rain washed the oil down the County road ditch on both sides of "Thomas" road to the North approximately 200 yards and then approximately 100 yards East and West near the old railroad right away. The oil has wicked up on the vegetation along the spillage path and some oil is pooled on the West side of the railroad right away.

You will be required to complete the cleanup by Monday April 5, 2021. Failure to meet the April 5, 2021 deadline will result in penalty recommendations in the amount of \$5,000 for failure to clean up the spill; 3rd violation. Operator was sent the attached Notice of Violation letter dated 3/24/2021 with a deadline of 4/05/2021 to complete the cleanup of spill number 28425.

Findings:

I arrived on location on 4/12/2021 and found while the operator had performed some work to spill # 28425 cleanup was not complete. The operator had applied straw in the east road ditch but oil was still showing in places in the ditch. The straw needs to have been removed and spag sorb needs to have been incorporated into the spill area. After the spill exited the ditch traveling east I found two locations where a small amount of spag sorb had been applied. The majority of this area still had oil present that had not yet been addressed. This oil is still capable of spreading, impacting a larger area since this area appears to be drainage from rain events. When I investigated the pond on the west side of the load I found a small amount of oil sheen or rainbow on the water's surface. However the majority of the oil had stained the vegetation along the banks of the pond or within the pond. I have had no contact with the operator or operator's staff since my initial investigation on 3/15/2021. I have attached the thirteen (13) photos that were taken while on location. I have also attached the Notice of Violation letter that was sent 3/24/2021 with a deadline to complete cleanup by 4/05/2021.






