ORDER DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER AND SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the following:

- 1. On February 13, 2020, the Commission issued a *Penalty Order* against Millennium Oil & Gas, Inc. (Operator) for one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-120 because unplugged wells, for which Operator was responsible, remained on Operator's expired license.¹
- 2. On March 12, 2020, Operator submitted a *Letter on Penalty Order*, but did not indicate that it desired a hearing. On March 13, 2020, Commission Staff sent a letter inquiring whether Operator was requesting a hearing, and stating a March 27, 2020, deadline to request a hearing.² Pursuant to K.S.A. 55-164 and K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, however, Operator's statutory deadline for submitted a request for hearing would have been March 19, 2020.³
- 3. On March 19, 2020, the Commission issued an *Emergency Order Staying All Dockets* (Emergency Order) staying all open dockets and suspending all deadlines in all open Commission

dockets, effective immediately. The *Emergency Order* applied to Commission conservation division matters until April 23, 2020. 5

- 4. On April 6, 2020, Operator submitted a request for hearing, with a signature date of March 23, 2020.⁶ Because Operator's deadline for submitting a request for hearing had been stayed pursuant to the *Emergency Order*, the Commission shall consider the request for hearing to be timely.
- 5. The Commission finds a Prehearing Officer should be designated in this proceeding to address any matters listed in K.S.A. 77-517(b), and a Prehearing Conference should be scheduled.
- 6. Although a Prehearing Officer is designated, parties are still required to file pleadings with the Commission, and filings shall be made with the Commission's Docket Room before 5:00 p.m. on the date scheduled for service. Any electronic service received after the deadline set forth in the procedural schedule, or any filing made after 5:00 p.m. on the date scheduled for service, shall be accompanied by a Motion to File Out-of-Time.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. The Prehearing Officer in this proceeding shall be Jonathan R. Myers, Assistant General Counsel, Kansas Corporation Commission, 266 N. The Commission directs electronic service of all filings in the docket to include service on the Prehearing Officer and mailed service of all filings to be directed to the Prehearing Officer's attention.

C. At the Prehearing Conference, parties shall be prepared to discuss deadlines for filing testimony and briefs, discovery procedures, scheduling of a hearing with the Commission, and any other issues that will promote the orderly and prompt resolution of this proceeding.

D. At the Prehearing Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA). Any party that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the KAPA.⁸

E. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.⁹
