**PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER SETTING STATUS CONFERENCE**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

1. On October 29, 2018, RedBud Oil & Gas Operating, LLC (Operator) filed an Application to authorize injection of natural gas into the Cattleman formation at the Westfall #2E-12 well, located in Montgomery County, Kansas.<sup>1</sup> A hearing on the Application is currently scheduled for April 18, 2019, and the first pre-filed direct testimony deadline in the docket is March 4, 2019.<sup>2</sup>

2. The Prehearing Officer finds it appropriate to set a status conference in this docket, so that he may be apprised of the potential need and timeframe for parties to obtain counsel; for potentially obtaining consent to electronic service of documents; to hear from parties regarding the likelihood of settlement; and to hear any other preliminary issues that may arise.
