PRE-FILED TESTIMONY

OF

JONELLE RAINS

1 Q. What is your name and business address?
2 A. Jonelle Rains, 266 North Main Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202.
3 Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?
4 A. I am employed by the Conservation Division of the Kansas Corporation Commission as
5 the Environmental Protection and Remediation (“EP&R”) Supervisor.
6 Q. How long have you been employed by the KCC?
7 A. About 33 years.
8 Q. Have you previously testified before this Commission?
9 A. No.
10 Q. What does your position with the Conservation Division involve?
11 A. I supervise Staff tasked with processing surface pit applications, spill reports,
12 environmental site assessment requests, operator well transfers, operator well inventories,
13 and similar matters.
14 Q. Are you familiar with this docket, 16-CONS-4131-CSHO?
15 A. Yes.
16 Q. How are you familiar with this docket?
17 A. I have reviewed all pertinent Commission files regarding the well at issue, specifically
18 the Brown #2.
19 Q. Is the Brown #2 abandoned and unplugged?
20 A. Yes. Commission District #3 Staff Duane Sims’s February 22, 2016, inspection report
21 (Exhibit A) indicates the well is abandoned and unplugged. I do not believe any party to
22 this proceeding disputes the current status of the well, which to my knowledge remains
23 unchanged since the February 22, 2016, inspection.
24 Q. Who drilled the Brown #2, and when was it drilled?
25 A. On October 20, 1982, Summer Sun Gas L.L.C. filed a Well Completion Report (“ACO-
26 1”) indicating that Summer Sun Gas drilled the well in July 1982 (Exhibit B).
27 Q. Has the well ever produced?
28 A. Not to Staff’s knowledge. Publicly available Kansas Geological Survey data shows no
29 indication of any sales ever occurring from the well. However, a residential gas well
30 would not show any sales.
31 Q. Does Commission Staff have any other pertinent documents regarding the well?

1 A. Yes. We have a Well Plugging Application ("CP-1") filed by Summer Sun Gas, Inc., on
2 September 30, 2016, which has been approved (Exhibit C).

3 Q. Are there any other pertinent documents?

4 A. Yes. We have an agreement from November 1986, whereby George Lowell Brown and
5 Barbara Jean Brown state they accept responsibility for plugging the wells. The
6 agreement is also signed by Gary D. Cude (Exhibit D).

7 Q. Who are George Lowell Brown and Barbara Jean Brown?

8 A. I do not have firsthand knowledge, but I believe they are the deceased parents of Ronald
9 Brown and John Brown, who are parties to this proceeding.

10 Q. Who is Gary D. Cude?

11 A. My understanding is that he was the owner of Summer Sun Gas L.L.C. and is now the
12 owner of Summer Sun Gas, Inc. Both Gary D. Cude and Summer Sun Gas, Inc. have
13 been joined in this proceeding as the successors in interest to Summer Sun Gas L.L.C.

14 Q. Is there any other information you have worth mentioning to the Commission?

15 A. Yes. In October 2016, John Brown obtained a KCC license (#35402). As part of his
16 license application he filed a Well Inventory (Exhibit E). The Brown #2 was listed as an
17 inactive gas well. My understanding is that Mr. Brown said he would file the Transfer of
18 Operator ("T-1") form necessary to put the well on his license, but to date he has not.

19 Q. Is the well still on Summer Sun's previous license, KCC License #6880?

20 A. Yes.

21 Q. Under K.A.R. 82-3-136, who is responsible for ensuring T-1 forms are filed?

22 A. The past operator.

23 Q. In this case, who is the past operator?

24 A. Summer Sun.

25 Q. Has Commission Staff been denied access to the Brown #2?

26 A. No.

27 Q. From the perspective of Commission Staff, what needs to be done to resolve this matter?

28 A. Either the well needs to be plugged or it needs to be transferred to an active operator's
29 license through the filing of an acceptable T-1 form.

30 Q. Does this conclude your testimony as of this date, January 17, 2017?

31 A. Yes.

Dear Gary Cude:

The Conservation Division has received your Well Plugging Application (CP-1).

Under K.A.R. 82-3-113(b)(2), you must notify DISTRICT 3 of your proposed plugging plan at least 5 days before plugging the well. DISTRICT 3's phone number is (620) 432-2300. Failure to notify DISTRICT 3, or failure to file a Well Plugging Record (CP-4) after the well is plugged will result in a penalty recommendation.

Under K.A.R. 82-3-600, you must file an Application for Surface Pit (CDP-1) if you wish to use a workover pit while plugging the well. Failure to timely file a CDP-1, failure to timely remove fluids, or failure to timely file Closure of Surface Pit (CDP-4) or Waste Transfer (CDP-5) forms will result in a penalty recommendation.

This receipt does NOT constitute authorization to plug this well if you do not otherwise have the legal right to do so.

This receipt is VOID after March 31, 2017. If the well is not plugged by then, you will have to submit a new CP-1 if you wish to plug the well.

The March 31, 2017 deadline does NOT override any compliance deadline given to you by Legal, District, or other Commission Staff. Failure to comply with any given deadline will still result in the Commission assessing penalties, or taking other legal action.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 25th day of November, 1986, by and between George Lowell Brown and Barbara Jean Brown, his wife, of RFD, Sedan, Chautauqua County, Kansas, Parties of the First Part, and Gary D. Cude, of Sedan, Chautauqua County, Kansas, Party of the Second Part.

WHEREAS, by an oil and gas lease dated June 7, 1980, Parties of the First Part did make, execute, and deliver to W. M. Huffine, an oil and gas lease covering the following described real estate located in Chautauqua County, Kansas, to wit:

said lease being for a primary term of three years. That by various assignments, said oil and gas lease was assigned to Gary D. Cude, that gas wells were drilled upon said property, but are no longer operated by the lessee or his assigns, so that said oil and gas lease has terminated by its own terms and conditions, but that said wells have never been plugged and it is the desire of Parties of the First Part that they be not plugged and said Parties of the First Part are willing to assume the responsibility for the operation of said wells, if they are to be operated, and the responsibility for plugging said wells in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Conservation Division of the Kansas Corporation Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the release of said lease and the transfer of all right, title, and interest in and to said wells to Parties of the First Part by Party of the Second Part, Parties of the First Part do hereby assume the responsibility for the operation of said wells, should they be operated, and for the abandonment and plugging of said wells in the event that they are required to be plugged, and do hereby relieve Party of the Second Part from any and all further responsibility for said gas wells, their operation or abandonment.

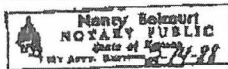

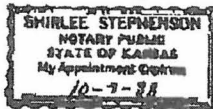
