ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR LICENSE

The Commission rules as follows:

I. JURISDICTION

- 1. Under K.S.A. 55-155, the Commission is authorized to license operators and contractors as defined by K.S.A. 55-150.
- 2. Under K.S.A. 55-155(c)(3), (4), and K.A.R. 82-3-120(g), to obtain approval of a license or license renewal, an applicant:
 - a. If registered with the federal securities and exchange commission, must demonstrate to the Commission's satisfaction that the applicant complies with all requirements of Chapter 55 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, all rules and regulations adopted thereunder and all commission orders and enforcement agreements; or
 - b. If not registered with the federal securities and exchange commission, must demonstrate to the Commission's satisfaction that the following individuals comply with all requirements of Chapter 55 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated and amendments thereto, all rules and regulations adopted thereunder, and all commission orders and enforcement agreements: (1) the applicant; (2) any officer, director, partner, or member of the applicant; (3) any stockholder owning in the aggregate more that 5% of the stock of the applicant; and (4)

any spouse, parent, brother, sister, child, parent-in-law, brother-in-law, or sister-in-law of the foregoing.

3. K.A.R. 82-3-120(i) provides that an application or renewal application shall be denied if the applicant has not satisfied the requirements of K.A.R. 82-3-120, that denial of a license constitutes a summary proceeding under K.S.A. 77-537, and that a denial pursuant to K.S.A. 55-155(c)(3) or (4) is considered a license revocation. K.S.A. 55-155(e) and K.A.R. 82-3-120(j) provide that upon revocation of a license, no new license shall be issued to that operator or contractor until after the expiration of one year from the date of the revocation.

II. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 4. On March 24, 2022, Operator submitted an application for license renewal. Upon review, Commission Staff determined the application did not meet the requirements of K.S.A. 55-155(c) and K.A.R. 82-3-120(g) because Operator's license was suspended for non-compliance with the Commission's Penalty Orders in Dockets 22-CONS-3198-CPEN and 22-CONS-3292-CPEN.¹
- 5. The Commission notes that Operator stated in its license renewal application that it was in full compliance with Commission rules, regulations, orders, and enforcement agreements, even though Operator's license was suspended for non-compliance with Commission orders in two dockets.²
- 6. On March 25, 2022, Commission Staff sent a letter to Operator stating Staff would recommend denial of Operator's application if the underlying compliance issues were not resolved by April 25, 2022.³ Operator came into compliance with Docket 22-CONS-3198-CPEN on March 31, 2022, but did not come into compliance with Docket 22-CONS-3292-CPEN.⁴

7. To date, Operator's license is still suspended for non-compliance with the Commission's Penalty Order in Docket 22-CONS-3292-CPEN.⁵ The Commission also notes that Operator's license has been suspended for failure to comply with the Commission's Shut-In Order in Docket 22-CONS-3418-CPEN.⁶

III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8. Operator's application does not meet the requirements of K.S.A. 55-155(c)(4) and K.A.R. 82-3-120(g)(2), because Operator is suspended for non-compliance with a Commission penalty order.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. Operator's license application is denied. Operator may not reapply until at least one year from the date of this denial.
- B. Operator's application is being denied via summary proceedings; thus this Order Denying Application for License does not take effect until after the time for requesting a hearing has expired.⁷ Any party may request a hearing on the above issues by submitting a written request setting for the specific grounds upon which relief is sought, to the Commission at 266 N. Main, Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202, within 15 days from the date of service of this Order.⁸ If a hearing is not requested, then this Order Denying Application for License shall become effective upon expiration of the time for requesting hearing.⁹ A request for hearing must comply with K.A.R. 82-1-219.
- C. If this Order Denying Application for License becomes effective, then any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).¹⁰
