STAFF'S MOTION TO SET PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Staff" and "Commission," respectively), by and through its counsel, Ahsan A. Latif, hereby files its Motion for Prehearing Conference. In Support, Staff states as follows:

- 1. On November 15 to December 8, 2021, Staff Special Investigators, Penny Fryback and Erica Pargas, conducted a safety compliance review of the operations of Mast Trucking Inc (Mast Trucking or Carrier).
- 2. On December 21, 2021, the Commission issued a penalty to Mast Trucking, totaling \$6,500 in civil fines comprised of four alleged violations. The four alleged violations including a \$5,000 enhanced fine for allowing or permitting drivers to falsify records of duty status.
- 3. Mast Trucking had previously been issued a penalty for the same violation, in a Penalty Order issued by the Commission on March 10, 2020.¹
- 4. On December 23, 2021, Mast Trucking Inc filed a request for hearing before the Commission disputing only the violation alleging Carrier allowed or permitted drivers to falsify records of duty status.

5. Carrier and Transportation Staff met on February 17, 2022 and held subsequent

discussions on the possibility of settlement.

6. On June 15, 2022, Mast Trucking Inc requested that the parties proceed with

setting a hearing date in this matter.

7. Staff requests this docket be referred to the Office of General Counsel for a pre-

hearing conference.

8. Staff requests a Prehearing Conference be scheduled in this docket for the purpose

of setting a procedural schedule and hearing date in this matter.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests a Prehearing Officer be appointed and also

that a Prehearing conference be scheduled so the parties can set a date related to Respondent's

Request for Hearing.
