CERTIFICATE

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes on for consideration and determination by the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission"). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On June 18, 2015 Black Hills/Kansas Gas Utility Company, LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy ("Applicant") filed an application seeking a Certificate of Convenience and Authority to provide natural gas service to a portion of Finney County, Kansas as required by K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 66-131. Applicant is a natural gas public utility as defined by K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 66-104. A public hearing was neither requested nor held on this application.
- 2. Specifically, Applicant requests a Certificate in the territory described as follows: FINNEY COUNTY

Sections 7, 17 and 18, Township 25 South, Range 32 West

3. The territory described in Finding No. 2 above is currently served by Midwest Energy, Inc. Pursuant to Docket No. 15-MDWG-593-CCS, Midwest Energy, Inc. requests permission to cease operating as a natural gas public utility in that territory.

4. Public convenience will be promoted by allowing Applicant to provide natural gas service in the territory described in Finding No. 2 above. The application, therefore, should be granted and a Certificate issued to Applicant in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 66-131.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION CONSIDERED AND CERTIFIED:

A. The application filed herein is granted and Black Hills/Kansas Gas Utility Company, LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy is permitted to transact the business of a natural gas public utility in the territory described in Finding No. 2 herein.

B. A party may file a petition for reconsideration of this Order within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order. If service is by mail, service is complete upon mailing, and three (3) days shall be added to the above time frame. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 77-529.

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction of the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.

BACKGROUND:

On June 18, 2015, Midwest Energy, Inc. (Midwest) filed an Application to Cease Service and Black Hills/Kansas Gas Utility Company, LLC, dba Black Hills Energy (Black Hills) filed a companion Application for Certificate.

ANALYSIS:

Pursuant to K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 66-131, the Commission has jurisdiction to grant a certificate to a public utility seeking to transact business in the State of Kansas.

The statutory standard of review in this matter is whether the "public convenience will be promoted by the transaction of said business and permitting said applicants to transact the business of a common carrier or public utility in this state." K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 66-131.

Report and Recommendation Page 2

An irrigation customer in Finney County currently using natural gas from a local gas well to fuel four irrigation engines has requested natural gas service from Black Hills. The irrigation sites are located in an area certificated to Midwest, adjacent to Black Hills' territory. In order to meet this customers service needs, the two utilities have agreed to exchange three sections of territory.

Staff recommends that the Commission find that public convenience will be promoted by the granting of this Application.

The Commission action date is December 15, 2015.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff is recommending that Midwest's Application to Cease Service in 15-MDWG-593-CCS and Black Hills' Application for Certificate in 15-BHCG-596-COC both be granted.
