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APPLICATION

COMES NOW Lynn Packard (Applicant) in support of its Application in the captioned matter and states follows:

1. Applicant is owner of said land and owner operator of Packard 1-15 in the State of Kansas. Applicant's address is 8113 NW River Road, Medicine Lodge, Kansas 67104.
2. Applicant has been issued by the Kansas Corporation Commission Operator's License 33328.
3. Applicant is the owner and operator of the Packard 1-15 well, API# 15-007-24331-00-00 (the subject well), which is located in the SW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 31 South, Range 13 West, Barber County, Kansas. The subject pit is located on dry and abandoned oil and gas location on same land: Section 15, Township 31 South, Range 13 West, Barber County, Kansas.

4. K.A.R. 82-3-100 (b) states the commission may grant an exception to the requirements of any of its regulations. K.A.R. 82-3-602 (a) (2) limits pit closure extensions to two three month extensions. Applicant respectfully requests such extension.

5. The pit has been lined with bentonite, and no chemicals are within the pit. Therefore, the exception will cause no environmental harm.

6. The landowner, Lynn Packard, has requested Kansas Corporation Commission to allow landowner unrestricted usage of the pit. Kansas Corporation Commission will allow landowner usage of the pit, upon written approval from the KCC.

7. The names and addresses of the unleased mineral owners of record and operators of lessees of record within one half (1/2) mile of the subject well entitled to receive notice of this Application are shown on attached Exhibit "A".

8. Applicant has included a plat map showing the location of the Packard 1-15 location.

9. Applicant has been advised that the landowner, Mr. Lynn Packard, has submitted a written request to KCC to acquire usage of the pit. Mr. Packard has advised that a KCC representative from the Wichita office has already been to the location and review the request, and has tentatively approved the request, subject to the approval of this Application.

WHEREFOR, Lynn Packard prays that this Application be docketed by the Commission and that if no written protest is received within (15) days after Notice of the Application is published and has been duly provided to all interested parties, that the Commission issue an order administratively granting Lynn Packard's request for an exception to the two three month extention time limitation set forth in K.A.R. 82-3-602 (a) (2) and allow transfer of the pit to the landowner. In the event a timely and proper protest is filed with the Commission, Lynn Packard requests the the Commission set this Application for hearing and, upon such hearing, grant the request order for exception and afford such other and further relief as the Commission deems necessary and proper.

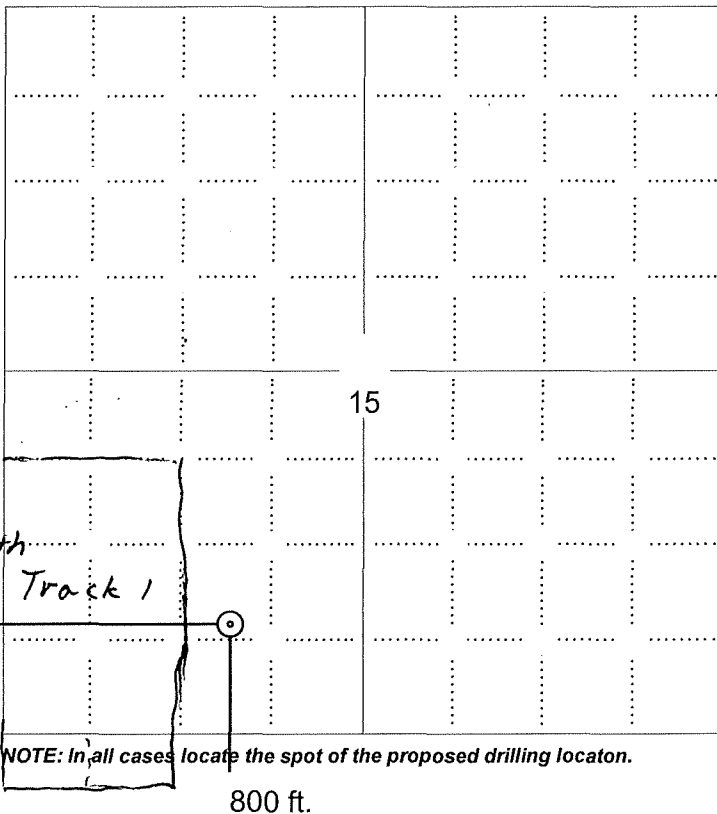

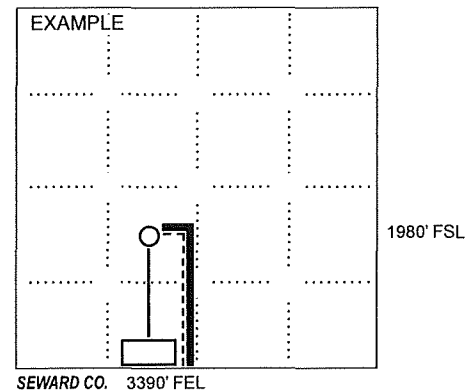
