STAFF OBJECTION TO MID-KANSAS' REQUEST FOR AN ORDER WITHIN 90 DAYS

COMES NOW, the Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Staff" and "Commission," respectively), and hereby submits this response to the application of Mid-Kansas Electric Company, LLC ("Mid-Kansas") in the above captioned docket.

Specifically, in response to Mid-Kansas' request for the Commission to issue an order on the application within ninety (90) days of filing. Staff states as follows:

- 1. Mid-Kansas, Staff and the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board ("CURB") filed a joint petition for a waiver of filing requirements on January 3, 2012, which opened this docket. The parties asked the Commission to waive certain filing requirements of K.A.R. 82-1-231 and permit Mid-Kansas to file an application which included a list of supporting documents attached to the petition. The Commission issued an order granting the requested waiver on January 25, 2012.
- 2. Mid-Kansas filed its application on February 1, 2012. Mid-Kansas requested expedited treatment of its application, requesting an order from the Commission within 90 days of filing. Mid-Kansas discussed proceeding with this application on a schedule of less than 240 days, however, it is not possible for Staff to conduct a review of the application and file testimony, which would enable the Commission to issue an order on or before May 1, 2012.

3. Furthermore, in the event that an evidentiary hearing is necessary, there is no possible way that a schedule could be developed to include hearing dates and a briefing schedule that would enable the Commission to issue a final order on or before May 1, 2012.

WHEREFORE, Staff hereby objects to Mid-Kansas' request for an order to be issued within 90 days of the date of filing of its application and requests the Commission deny such request.
