

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# ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION OF

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UNITED WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS, INC.

SEGRETARI OF STATE
KANSAS

The undersigned incorporator hereby forms and establishes a corporation for profit under the General Corporation Code of the State of Kansas.

#### ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation is United Wireless Communications, Inc.

### ARTICLE II PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Kansas General Corporation Code and not forbidden by law or these Articles of Incorporation.

# ARTICLE III PLACE OF PRINCIPAL BUSINESS AND RESIDENT AGENT

The location of its registered agent in Kansas is 1107 McArtor Road, Dodge City, Kansas 67801, County of Ford, and the registered agent in charge thereof at such address is Craig Mock.

#### ARTICLE IV DURATION

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

#### ARTICLE V MANAGEMENT

For management of business, for the conduct of the affairs of the corporation, and for the further definition, limitation, and regulation of the powers of the corporation and its directors and stockholders, it is further provided:

- Section 1. <u>Size of Board.</u> The number of directors shall be specified in the Bylaws of the corporation and such number may be from time to time increased or decreased in such manner as prescribed by the Bylaws.
- Section 2. <u>Voting.</u> In the election of directors, the stockholders shall be entitled to cumulate their votes.

Section 3. <u>Powers of Board.</u> In furtherance and not in limitation of the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Kansas, the Board of Directors is expressly authorized and empowered:

- (a) To make, alter, amend, and repeal the Bylaws, subject to the power of the stockholders to alter or repeal the Bylaws made by the Board of Directors.
- (b) Subject to the applicable provisions of the Bylaws then in effect, to determine from time to time whether and to what extent, and at what times and places, and under what conditions and regulations the accounts and books of the corporations, or any of them, shall be open for stockholders inspection. No stockholder shall have any right to inspect any of the accounts, books, or documents of the corporation, except as permitted by law, unless and until authorized to do so by resolution of the Board of Directors or of the stockholders of the corporation.
- (c) To borrow money for any of the purposes of the corporation from time to time without limit as to amount and to secure such borrowings by mortgage or pledge of, or the conveyance or assignment in trust of, the whole or any part of the properties (real and personal), assets, business and goodwill of the corporation including stock then owned or thereafter acquired.
- (d) To make any guaranty respecting indebtedness, interest, notes, contracts, or other obligations so far as the same may be permitted to be done by a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Kansas; and
- (e) In addition to the powers and authority hereinbefore or by statute expressly conferred upon it, the Board of Directors may exercise all such powers and do all such acts and things as may be exercised or done by the corporation subject, nevertheless, to the provisions of the laws of the State of Kansas, of these Articles of Incorporation, and the Bylaws of the corporation.

### POWERS

The corporation may exercise any powers without limitation whatsoever which a corporation may legally exercise under the General Corporation Code of the State of Kansas, under which the corporation is formed. In addition, the corporation shall have the following specific powers:

- (a) To elect or appoint officers and agents of the corporation and to fix their compensation;
- (b) To act as an agent for any individual, association, partnership, corporation, or other legal entity;

- (c) To receive, acquire, hold, or exercise rights arising out of ownership or possession thereof, sell or otherwise dispose of interests in or obligations of individuals, associations, partnerships, corporations, or governments; and
- (d) To receive, acquire, hold, pledge, transfer, or otherwise dispose of shares of other corporations.

#### ARTICLE VII CAPITAL STOCK

The corporation shall have authority to issue capital stock. The total number of shares which the corporation is authorized to issue is 1,000,000 shares of common stock non-par.

# ARTICLE VIII AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES

The provisions of these Articles of Incorporation may be amended, altered, or repealed from time to time to the extent and in the manner prescribed by the laws of the State of Kansas and in the manner prescribed by the laws as are then in force may be added. 


