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In the matter of the Application of Taos Resources Operating Company LLC for an exception to the pit closure time limitation of K.A.R. 82-3-602(a)(2) at its Hawkins #27-1 located in Section 27, Township 32 South, Range 5 East, Cowley County, Kansas. Docket No. 19-CONS-3042-CEXC CONSERVATION DIVISION License No. 33372

ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION

The above captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings and conclusions:

I. JURISDICTION

1. The Commission has the exclusive jurisdiction and authority to regulate oil and gas activities in Kansas.¹

2. K.A.R. 82-3-602(a)(2) limits pit permit extensions to two, three-month extensions.

3. K.A.R. 82-3-100 provides that the Commission may grant an exception to any regulation after application and notice.

II. FINDINGS OF FACT

4. Taos Resources Operating Company LLC (Operator) conducts oil and gas activities in Kansas under active license number 33372.

5. On July 30, 2018, the Operator filed an Application requesting an exception to the time limitations for pit closures set out in K.A.R. 82-3-602(a)(2); for the reserve pit associated

with the Hawkins #27-1 well ("subject pit"). The Operator wishes to forego the pit closure requirements enabling it to transfer the pit to the landowner.

6. The landowner, Mr. Henry Hawkins, submitted a written request asking for the subject pit to remain open so he may use it as a stock water pond in the future. Mr. Hawkins took all future responsibility for the pond.²

7. The Operator has verified that notice was properly served and published, as required under K.A.R. 82-3-135a.

8. No protest was filed under K.A.R. 82-3-135b.

9. Staff recommended that the Operator's Application for an exception to the pit closure time limitations in K.A.R. 82-3-602(a)(2) be approved.

III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

7. The Commission finds and concludes that it has jurisdiction over the Operator in this matter.

8. The Commission finds and concludes the Application was filed in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Commission and in accordance with Kansas statutes.

9. The Commission finds and concludes that notice was properly served and published.

10. Based on the above facts, the Commission finds and concludes that the Application should be granted.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. The Operator's Application for an exception to K.A.R. 82-3-602(a)(2) is granted.

B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).³
