ORDER GRANTING MOTION

This Matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") on the Motion for Interim Relief of Sandridge Exploration and Production, LLC ("Sandridge"). Giving due consideration to the pleading and its regulations the Commission makes the following findings and conclusions.

- Sandridge filed an application seeking permission to flare gas from its Perth 3302
 #2-1H well in Sumner County on September 24, 2014.
- 2. On September 29, 2014 Sandridge filed its motion to flare gas from the Perth well during the pendency of its application.
- 3. In support of its motion Sandridge states that it has been flaring gas from the Perth well in accordance with the Commission's regulation but the time allowed for flaring is running out. It has installed facilities to safely flare the gas to prevent damage to persons and property. The flaring operation is designed to comply with all applicable air quality regulations. If Sandridge is not allowed to flare the gas it will have to shut in its Perth well.
- 4. The Commission finds that Sandridge has shown good cause why its motion should be granted. Granting the application will prevent waste by allowing Sandridge to produce its Perth well during the pendency of its application.

Sandridge should be required to meter the gas volumes being flared and to test the

gas for H20 content. The volumes flared and the H2S content of the gas should be reported to

Commission staff monthly.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION:

A. The Motion of Sandridge to flare gas from its Perth 3302 #2-1H well during the

pendency of its application in this docket is granted.

B. Sandridge is required to report gas volumes flared and the H2S content of the gas

monthly to Commission staff.

Any party affected by this Order may file with the Commission a petition for

reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529(a). Such petition shall be filed within fifteen (15)

days after service of this Order and must state the specific grounds upon which relief is

requested. This petition for reconsideration shall be filed with the Executive Director of the

Conservation Division, Finney State Office Building, 266 N. Main, Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas

67202-1315.

The Commission retains jurisdiction of the subject matter and the parties for the purpose

of entering such further Order or Orders as from time-to-time it may deem proper.
