Response of CURB to Staff's Report and Recommendation

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The Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board (CURB) submits its response to the *Staff Report and Recommendation* filed in the above-captioned docket on September 1, 2010.

1. CURB concurs with the recommendation of the Commission Staff to approve Westar Energy's application for recovery of an adjusted amount of \$10,731,209 through its Energy Efficiency Rider (EER).

2. CURB agrees with the recommendation of the Commission Staff to oppose the inclusion of regulatory costs in Westar Energy's application. Westar should seek recovery of such costs as a part of its general rate case applications. The rider is not intended to recoup general costs of regulation, but to provide more timely recovery of the costs of goods and services related to Westar's energy-efficiency and demand-side management portfolio.

3. In support of Staff's recommendation, CURB adds that Westar asked for and received authorization to implement this annual rider. Therefore, these annual tariff proceedings are conducted at the request of, and for the benefit of Westar, not its customers. The distinct regulatory costs associated with the rider applications could be avoided altogether if Westar had opted instead to seek recovery of these costs through its general rate case applications. Further, given that the company sought and received authorization to apply annually for recovery, the cost of doing so is now a predictable annual expense that is more appropriate for recovery in base rates.

4. CURB also agrees with the recommendation of the Commission Staff to deny recovery of costs in Westar's application that are associated with heat pump marketing. However, since the Commission has yet to develop policies concerning whether encouraging fuel-switching is a legitimate way to encourage energy efficiency, the rationale for denying these costs may be more properly founded in the fact that marketing expenses are generally not recoverable in rates at all, and certainly should not be considered "educational" expenses.

5. Furthermore, it is the Commission's purpose in allowing EE riders to encourage electric utilities to offer programs that will help delay the need for new generation facilities. Attempts to build load by marketing heat pumps does not serve that policy. While heat pump marketing is clearly not an education program, as Staff noted, it is not an energy-efficiency or demand-side management program, either. Therefore, recovery of these expenses through the EER would clearly be inappropriate, even if the Commission were to determine that they are eligible for recovery from customers through base rates.

6. In summary, CURB recommends that the Commission adopt the recommendations of Staff, whether for the reasons that Staff has articulated, or for the reasons articulated by CURB.


