B. At the Status Conference, parties shall be prepared to discuss deadlines for filing

testimony and briefs, discovery procedures, and scheduling of a hearing with the Commission.

C. At the Status Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be

converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as

provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA).³ Any party that fails to attend or

participate in the Status Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in

default pursuant to the KAPA.⁴

A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.⁵

E. Parties have 15 days from the date of electronic service of this Order to petition

for reconsideration.⁶

F. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the

purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
