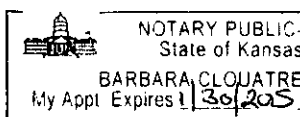

**NOTICE OF INFORMATIONAL MEETING CONCERNING
NATURAL GAS RATE INCREASE FILING
MADE AT KANSAS CORPORATION COMMISSION
AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**

American Energies Gas Service, LLC ("AEGS") filed an application with the Kansas Corporation Commission ("Commission" or "KCC") on October 2, 2014, for the purpose of establishing new rates for AEGS's retail and wholesale customers. AEGS filed an amended application with the KCC on October 28, 2014.

AEGS informed the KCC its new rates would produce an additional \$21,528.00 in annual revenues to pay for an increase in operating expenses and an additional \$51,206.00 in annual revenues to pay for an increase in gas gathering costs, for a total annual increase in revenues of \$72,734.00.

For a residential customer using 84 MMBtu per year, the proposed annual rate increase would be \$202.44, or \$16.87 per month.

AEGS is also seeking to increase some of its service fees and charges: Connection fees from \$5.00 to \$25.00; returned check charge from \$30.00 to \$35.00; collection charge from \$12.00 to \$20.00; disconnection charge from \$12.00 to \$15.00; reconnection charge from \$20.00 to \$25.00; and meter test charge from \$20.00 to \$25.00.

AEGS customers' rates have not increased since 2000 when the system was owned by Mac County Gas, Inc. The new rates, if approved by the KCC, would go into effect on March 1, 2015, or as soon thereafter as approved by the KCC.

AEGS will hold an informational meeting for AEGS's customers concerning the company's proposal. The informational meeting is scheduled for:
