



MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE

Atmos Energy ("Atmos") moves for an extension of time to file its response to the Report and Recommendation filed herein on May 5, 2014, by the Staff of the Kansas Corporation Commission ("Staff" and "Commission," respectively). Staff recommended the Commission require Atmos to show cause why it should not be assessed a penalty in the amount of \$72,000 for failure to comply with Kansas pipeline safety regulations. A response to Staff's Report and Recommendation is due May 19, 2014. Atmos requests it be granted additional time, or until June 2, 2014, in which to respond to Staff's Report and Recommendation. Staff has no objection to Atmos' request for extension of time to file a response.

WHEREFORE, Atmos moves the Commission for an Order granting it additional time, or until June 2, 2014, to respond to Staff's Report and Recommendation.



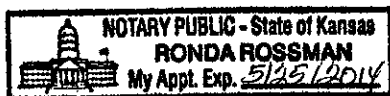


