Service Areas

Madison Telephone applies for a video service authorization for the following footprint in Greenwood County, Coffey County, and Lyon County, including the incorporated area of Madison.

Madison Exchange Area

Beginning at a point 1/4 mile east and 1/4 mile north of the southwest corner of Section 28, T21S, R10E, Lyon County, Kansas; thence east 3/4 mile; thence north 1/4 mile; thence east 3 1/2 miles; thence south 1/4 mile; thence east 1 3/4 miles; thence north 1 7/8 miles; thence east 1 1/4 miles; thence south 5/8 mile to a point 1/2 mile south and 1/2 mile east of the northwest corner of Section 22, T21S, R11E, thence east 4 miles; thence south 5/8 mile; thence east 1 mile; thence north 5/8 mile; thence east 3 miles; thence south 3 miles to a point 1/2 mile east and 1/2 mile south of the northwest corner of Section 1, T22S, R12E, Greenwood County; thence west 2 miles; thence south 7 miles; thence east 1/4 mile; thence south 3/4 mile; thence west 6 miles; thence north 3/4 mile; thence west 2 3/4 miles; thence north 1 mile; thence west 3 1/2 miles; thence north 3 miles; thence west 2 3/4 miles; thence north 2 miles; thence east 1 1/2 miles to a point 1/4 east and 1/2 mile south of the northwest corner of Section 9, T22S, R10E, Greenwood County; thence north 2 3/4 miles to a point of the beginning.

Lamont Exchange Area

Beginning at a point 1/2 mile west and 1/4 mile south of the northeast corner of Section 26, T21S, R13E, Coffey County; thence south 3 miles; thence west 1/2 mile to the Coffey-Greenwood County line; thence south along said county line 2 miles; thence west 1/4 mile to a point 1/4 mile west and 1/4 mile south of the northeast corner of Section 22, T22S, R13E, Greenwood County, Kansas; thence south 1 1/4 miles; thence east 1/8 mile; thence south 3 miles; thence west 2 3/8 miles to a point 1/2 mile south and 1/2 mile west of the northeast corner of Section 8, T23S, R13E, Greenwood County; thence south 1 1/4 miles; thence east 1 1/4 miles; thence south 1 3/4 miles; thence west 1/4 mile; thence north 3/8 mile to a point 1/8 mile south and 1/2 mile east of the northwest corner of Section 28, T23S, R13E, Greenwood County; thence west 5 miles; thence north 1 7/8 miles; thence east 1/4 mile; thence north 3/4 mile; thence west 1/4 mile; thence north 7 miles; thence east 2 miles; thence north 3 miles to a point 1/2 mile north and 1/2 mile east of the southwest corner of Section 24, T21S, R12E, Lyon County; thence east 1 mile; thence south 3/4 mile; thence east 4 miles to the point of beginning.

Madison Telephone plans to serve 100% of the footprint by June 1, 2013.

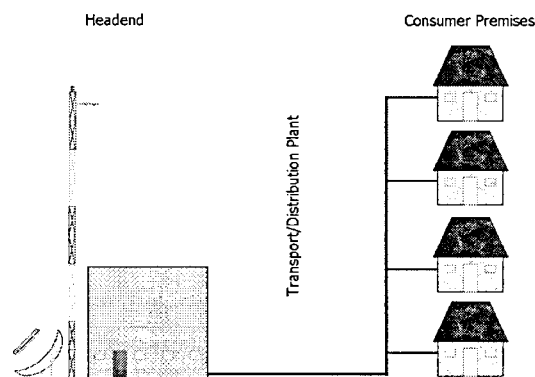

Network and Technology Overview

Madison's underlying technology can best be described when looked at as three separate but interconnected systems.



Headend

Madison shares a headend with other video providers. The headend is the source of all signals that are moving toward our subscribers and the destination for all signals that are coming back from the system. The headend houses an array of highly sophisticated equipment.

Transport & Distribution Plant

Most signals are transported via fiber optic cables from the shared headend to Madison's facilities using ethernet technology. At our facilities, we insert some local signals and distribute the combined signals to subscribers. Madison's plant is fiber-to-the-premises, meaning our signals are distributed between our facilities and the consumer premise over fiber optic technology.

Consumer Premises

The subscriber's location is the ultimate destination of our services and the origination point for customer-originated traffic. This includes technologies such as video-on-demand and pay-per-view.

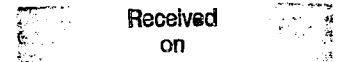
