You, and each of you, are hereby notified that Evans Oil, Inc. has filed an application to commence the injection of saltwater into the Bartlesville formation at the **R.E. Camp**, located in the **S36-T23-R21E #7-0E 4095' FSL 1915' FEL, #22-0E 5115' FSL 875' FEL, #23-0E 4930' FSL 1260' FEL, S26-T23-R21E #20-0E 280' FSL 490' FEL**, Bourbon County, Kansas, with a maximum operating pressure of **450'** and a maximum injection rate of **50 bbls per day**.

Any persons who object to or protest this application shall be required to file their objections or protest with the Conservation Division of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication. These protests shall be filed pursuant to Commission regulations and must state specifically why granting the application may cause waste, violate correlative rights or pollute the natural resources of the State of Kansas.
