This is a letter of protest against the drilling of the Clark#1 well located 1840 feet from the South line and 200 feet from the East line in the SE/4 of Section 15, Township 26 South, Range 2 East, Sedgwick County, Kansas.

As a mineral rights owner, whose property boundary is located less than 330' from the proposed well location. I am exercising my right to protest the drilling of this well. I moved into my current home knowing there were oil wells in the area. There is an inactive well within sight of my property that will be removed in due time. If this proposed well is drilled, it is my concern this could potentially affect the property values of homes in the area negatively or make it harder to sell a home within view of this well. The current wells do off-gas, sending an unpleasant odor into the air making it impossible to even have the windows open on my home when the odor is present. The potential well location will be even closer to my property than the other active wells by quite some distance, making it even more of a nuisance when it does put off an odor. In addition to odor, there are the noises these rigs can make. The inactive one closest to me when it was running made creaking and squeaking noises 24 hours a day, 7 days a week at times. I would consider this a noise issue, especially at night when trying to sleep, as I could hear it from within my home. Increased traffic on the road is a factor as well due to the activity required to keep these units running properly. A water well is located on my property that has potential of being impacted due to a well being drilled so close to my property boundary. A final concern has to do with the possibility of oil being drawn from my property without me seeing a penny of any profit. I have had an oil company approach me about drilling on my land. If this proposed well is put into production, I may go ahead and sign a lease because I might as well profit from one on my own property if another one ends up so close to me anyway, causing all the above mentioned concerns. This may or may not eat into Urban Oil's potential production at the location of the proposed well.
