**ORDER CONSOLIDATING DOCKETS, DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER
AND SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On August 31, 2017, the Commission issued Penalty Orders in Docket Nos. 18-CONS-3125-CPEN and 18-CONS-3128-CPEN, finding the Operator committed violations of K.A.R. 82-3-111 because the subject wells noted as the Clift #1, Sell A #1, Hazlett #2 and Hoffman G #32-1 have been inactive in excess of the time allowed by regulation without being plugged, returned to service, or approved for Temporary Abandonment (TA) status.¹ The Orders

fined the Operator \$300 and \$100 respectively and ordered the subject wells be returned to service or obtain TA status for the wells if eligible.²

2. On October 3, 2017, the Operator requested a hearing in both Dockets.

3. Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-224, the Commission may consolidate two or more dockets if the Commission deems it to be in the public interest. The Commission finds and concludes that the two Dockets shall be consolidated for administrative efficiency and cost.

4. The Commission finds that a Prehearing Officer should be designated in this proceeding to address matters pursuant to K.S.A. 77-516-517.³ The Commission also finds that a prehearing conference should be scheduled in this matter.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. Docket Nos. 18-CONS-3125-CPEN and 18-CONS-3128-CPEN shall be consolidated.

D. At the Prehearing Conference, parties shall be prepared to discuss deadlines for filing testimony and briefs, discovery procedures, and scheduling of a hearing with the Commission.

At the Prehearing Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA), K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.* Any party that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in default pursuant to KAPA.

F. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.⁴
