# NOTICE OF PENALTY ASSESSMENT

This is a notice of a penalty assessment against Circle H Transport, Inc. (Circle H Transport) for violation(s) of Kansas Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules, and Regulations discovered during a compliance review conducted on January 24, 2018, by Kansas Corporation Commission Special Investigator Michael McAvoy. Penalty amounts are assessed in accordance with the FY 2018 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix, approved by the Commission on June 27, 2017. For a full description of the penalty(s) and terms and obligations please refer to the Order attached to this notice.

**IF YOU ACCEPT THE PENALTY:** Circle H Transport has been assessed a \$300 penalty. You have thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Penalty Order to pay the penalty. Please remit payment of \$300, through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's KTRAN application located at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/. If you have not received a letter from the Transportation Division assigning you a PIN, please contact that Division at 785-271-3145. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty.

The Order requires Circle H Transport to submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within 18 months from the date of the attached Order. Transportation Staff will contact you at a later date to determine an appropriate time for this review.

**IF YOU CONTEST THE PENALTY ORDER: You have the right to request a hearing.** A request for hearing must be made in writing, setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. Circle H Transport must file, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, the request for hearing with the Commission's electronic filing system found at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/, and must mail a copy of the request to the undersigned at the above address. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven (7) copies of the request to the Secretary to the Commission at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy to the undersigned Litigation Counsel. K.A.R. 82-1-215; K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 77-542.

**IF YOU FAIL TO ACT:** Failure to pay the penalty of \$300 within thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order or failure to comply with the terms of the Order, or in the alternative, failure to provide a timely written request for a hearing, will result in the attached Order becoming final and may result in additional sanctions of suspension and/or revocation of your motor carrier operating authority.

# PENALTY ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

# I. JURISDICTION

- 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 66-1,108b, 66-1,111, 66-1,112, 66-1,114, 66-1,114b and 66-1,115, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 66-1,108, doing business or procuring business in Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority and jurisdiction.
- 2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130 and 66-1,142b, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard

to the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision or regulation of the Commission.

3. The Commission has the authority, pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-237, to investigate an entity under the Commission's jurisdiction and order a hearing on the Commission's own motion when the Commission believes the entity is in violation of the law or any order of the Commission.

#### II. BACKGROUND

- 4. Circle H Transport, Inc. (Circle H Transport) has private operating authority with the Commission and further operates USDOT number 811930.
- 5. Circle H Transport is a private motor carrier which primarily hauls grain, feed and hay.
- 6. Circle H Transport transports in commerce between states (interstate commerce), and is thereby subject to the Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) fees assessed pursuant to 49 C.F.R. 367.30, as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-30a.

#### III. STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 7. Pursuant to the jurisdiction and authority cited above, on January 24, 2018, Commission Staff (Staff) Special Investigator Michael McAvoy conducted a compliance review of the operations of Circle H Transport. A copy of the safety compliance review is included in this Penalty Order as Attachment "A" and is hereby incorporated by reference. As a result of this investigation, the special investigator identified one (1) violation(s) of the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations.
  - a. On December 26, 2017, Circle H Transport required or permitted its driver, Lonnie Rheinheimer, to operate a CDL-required commercial motor vehicle, a 2000 Peterbilt, VIN ending in 502393, GVWR 48,000 lbs., pulling a 2011

Wilson grain trailer, VIN ending in 256122, GVWR 65,000 lbs., in interstate commerce from Hugoton, Kansas to Boise City, Oklahoma. This trip is evidenced by Scale Ticket No. 58784, dated December 26, 2017, a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment "B" and is hereby incorporated by reference. At the time of this transportation, Circle H Transport had not registered and paid its Unified Commercial Registration fees to operate commercial motor vehicles in interstate commerce. The carrier's failure to annually register its commercial motor vehicle(s) operating in interstate commerce over the highways of this state and to pay the appropriate Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) fees as set out in 49 C.F.R. 367.30, is a violation of K.A.R. 82-4-30a, authorized by K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 66-1,139a and K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 66-1,129. Staff recommends a fine of \$300.

#### IV. STAFF'S RECOMMENDATIONS

- 8. Based upon the available facts, Staff recommends the Commission finds Circle H Transport committed one (1) violation(s) of Kansas law that governs motor carriers, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations, and is therefore subject to sanctions or fines imposed by the Commission.
- 9. Additionally, Staff recommends a civil penalty of \$300 for one (1) violation(s) of the Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules and Regulations.

10. Finally, Staff recommends that Circle H Transport submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order. Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for this review.

#### V. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 11. The Commission finds it has jurisdiction over Circle H Transport because it is a motor carrier as defined in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 66-1,108.
- 12. The Commission finds Circle H Transport committed one (1) violation(s) of Kansas law that governs motor carriers, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations, and is therefore subject to sanctions or fines imposed by the Commission.

#### THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:

- A. Circle H Transport, Inc., of Hugoton, Kansas is hereby assessed a \$300 civil penalty for one (1) violation(s) of Kansas law governing the regulation of motor carriers, the Kansas Administrative Regulations and provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations.
- B. Circle H Transport is ordered to submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order. Transportation Staff will contact the carrier to set up the appointment.
- C. On February 27, 2018, this Penalty Order was mailed to Circle H Transport via Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested, Receipt Number 70161970000105744158. Service of this Order is complete upon the date delivered shown on the Domestic Return Receipt.
- D. Pursuant to K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, any party may request a hearing on the above issue(s) by submitting a written request setting forth the specific grounds

upon which relief is sought. The request may be electronically filed with the Commission's electronic filing system at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, and a copy of the request mailed to the Litigation Division. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven (7) copies of the request to the Secretary to the Commission, at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy of the request to Litigation Counsel. A hearing will be scheduled only upon written request. Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of Circle H Transport's right to a hearing, and this Penalty Order will become a Final Order assessing a \$300 civil penalty against Circle H Transport, and ordering it to submit to a safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order.

- E. Attorneys for all parties shall enter their appearances in Commission proceedings by giving their names and addresses for the record. For civil penalties exceeding \$500, a corporation shall appear before the Commission by its attorney, unless waived by the Commission for good cause shown and a determination that such waiver is in the public interest. K.S.A. 77-515(c); K.A.R. 82-1-228(d)(2); K.A.R. 82-1-202(a). For civil penalties of \$500 or less, a corporation may appear by a duly authorized representative of the corporation. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 66-1,142b(e) and amendments thereto.
- F. If you do not request a hearing, the payment of the civil penalty of \$300 is due in thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order. Payment of \$300 must be made through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's KTRAN application located at <a href="https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/">https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/</a>. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty owed.




