# ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records and being fully advised of all matters of record, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On May 15, 2015, Stephen and Karen Gradwohl filed a Formal Complaint with the Commission against Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L).
- 2. KCP&L filed its Answer and Motion to Dismiss on June 11, 2015, with an errata being filed June 12, 2015 containing Attachment D inadvertently omitted from the June 11, 2015 filing.
  - 3. Staff filed its Report and Recommendation (R&R) on September 28, 2015.
- 4. Pursuant to Kansas Administrative Regulation (K.A.R.) 82-1-218(d), any party may respond within ten (10) days from the date of service of any notice. Ten days from the date of the Notice of Filing Staff's R&R is October 8, 2015.
- 5. On October 7, 2015, KCP&L requested an extension of time until November 9, 2015 to respond to Staff's R&R citing the need for additional time to gather facts and information related to Staff's R&R, and specifically the Staff's assertion of a new interpretation of the Kansas Underground Utility Damage Prevention Act (KUUDPA) which KCP&L desires to fully analyze prior to filing a response with the Commission.

6. Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-217(b), the Commission has discretion to grant extensions of time for good cause shown.

7. This is KCP&L's first request for an extension of time to respond to the Staff's R&R dated September 28, 2015. KCP&L indicates that Staff has no objection to the motion for extension of time.

8. The Commission finds that under the circumstances described above, the extension should be granted.

### THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. The motion for extension of time for KCP&L to respond to Staff's September 28, 2015 Report & Recommendation from October 8, 2015 to November 9, 2015 is granted.

B. Electronic service will be used in this proceeding, including this Order.

C. The parties have 15 days from the date this Order was electronically served to petition for reconsideration.<sup>1</sup>

D. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
