## **ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR LICENSE**

The Commission rules as follows:

#### I. **JURISDICTION**

1. Under K.S.A. 55-155, the Commission is authorized to license operators and

contractors as defined by K.S.A. 55-150.

2. Under K.S.A. 55-155(c)(3), (4), and K.A.R. 82-3-120(g), to obtain approval of a

license or license renewal, an applicant:

- If registered with the federal securities and exchange commission, must a. demonstrate to the Commission's satisfaction that the applicant complies with all requirements of Chapter 55 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, all rules and regulations adopted thereunder and all commission orders and enforcement agreements; or
- If not registered with the federal securities and exchange commission, must b. demonstrate to the Commission's satisfaction that the following individuals comply with all requirements of Chapter 55 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated and amendments thereto, all rules and regulations adopted thereunder, and all

commission orders and enforcement agreements: (1) the applicant; (2) any officer, director, partner, or member of the applicant; (3) any stockholder owning in the aggregate more that 5% of the stock of the applicant; and (4) any spouse, parent, brother, sister, child, parent-in-law, brother-in-law, or sister-in-law of the foregoing.

3. K.A.R. 82-3-120(i) provides an application or renewal application shall be denied if the applicant has not satisfied the requirements of K.A.R. 82-3-120, denial of a license constitutes a summary proceeding under K.S.A. 77-537, and a denial pursuant to K.S.A. 55-155(c)(3) or (4) is considered a license revocation. K.S.A. 55-155(e) and K.A.R. 82-3-120(j) provide that upon revocation of a license, no new license shall be issued to that operator or contractor until after the expiration of one year from the date of the revocation.

### II. FINDINGS OF FACT

4. On June 1, 2020, Operator submitted an application for license renewal.<sup>1</sup> Operator does not appear to be currently registered with the federal securities and exchange commission.<sup>2</sup>

5. On April 2, 2021, Commission Staff Counsel mailed Operator a letter indicating Operator was associated with MC C Oil Company, Inc., license #31411, which is not in compliance with all requirement of K.S.A. Chapter 55.<sup>3</sup> Staff gave Operator until April 30, 2021, to resolve its compliance issues in order to prevent its license renewal application from being denied.<sup>4</sup> Specifically, Mark W. McCann appears as an officer, director, partner, or member of Operator, and as an officer, director, partner or member of MC C Oil Company, which has four

unplugged wells remaining on its expired license.<sup>5</sup> MC C Oil Company's license is also suspended under KCC Docket 16-CONS-361-CSHO.

6. Upon review of Operator's application and Commission records, the Commission also notes that Operator stated in its application that it was in full compliance with Commission rules, regulations, orders, and enforcement agreements, but at that time Operator's license was suspended for non-compliance with Commission orders in consolidated Dockets 19-CONS-3271/3272-CPEN.<sup>6</sup>

## III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

7. Operator's application does not meet the requirements of K.S.A. 55-155(c)(4) and K.A.R. 82-3-120(g)(2), because Operator, not registered with the federal securities and exchange commission, has an officer, director, partner, or member who does not comply with all requirements of Chapter 55 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated and amendments thereto, all rules and regulations adopted thereunder, and all commission orders and enforcement agreements.

8. The Commission has insufficient data to determine whether Operator is in compliance with all rules and regulations of the Commission.

### THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

A. Operator's license application is denied. Operator may not reapply until at least one year from the date of this denial.

B. Operator may request a hearing on the above issues by submitting a written request, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, to the Commission at 266 N. Main, Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202, within 15 days from the date of service of this Order. <u>A request for hearing must comply with K.A.R. 82-1-219.</u>

C. Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of Operator's right to a hearing. If no party timely requests a hearing, then this Order shall become final. A party may petition for reconsideration of a final order pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).<sup>7</sup>

Commission Staff is in receipt of your June 1, 2020 license renewal application. Available records indicate an association with MC C Oil Company, Inc., license #31411 (Associated Entity), which is not in compliance with all requirements of K.S.A. Chapter 55. The Associated Entity has 4 unplugged wells remaining on its expired license and is suspended under KCC Docket 16-CONS-361-CSHO.

Under K.S.A. 55-155(c)(4), no application or renewal shall be approved until the applicant has demonstrated to the Commission's satisfaction that the operator complies with all requirements of K.S.A. Chapter 55, all rules and regulations adopted thereunder, and all Commission orders and enforcement actions.

Staff cannot approve your application at this time due to your association with entities that are not in compliance with Commission statutes, regulations and orders. If the underlying compliance issues are not resolved then Staff shall recommend to the Commission that your license renewal application be denied.

Failure to resolve any compliance issues by April 30, 2021, may result in your license renewal application being denied.
