PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER CONSOLIDATING DOCKETS, REGARDING ELECTRONIC SERVICE, AND SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

I. Background

1. <u>Commission Docket 20-CONS-3043-CUIC.</u> On July 10, 2019, TDR Construction,

Inc. (Operator) filed an application seeking authorization for injection of saltwater into the Moldenhauer #W-42 well in Franklin County.¹ On August 5, 2019, Scott Yeargain and Polly Shteamer (Protesters) filed a protest.² On October 1, 2019, the Commission scheduled a prehearing conference in this matter for October 15, 2019, at 1:30 p.m.³

2. <u>Commission Docket 20-CONS-3079-CUIC.</u> On August 30, 2019, Operator filed an application seeking authorization for injection of saltwater into the Moldenhauer #30 and Moldenhauer #45 wells in Franklin County.⁴ On September 5, 2019, Protesters filed a protest.⁵ On October 1, 2019, the Commission scheduled a prehearing conference in this matter for October 15, 2019, at 1:45 p.m.⁶

3. On October 15, 2019, the Prehearing Officer, with the permission of all parties, called both scheduled prehearing conferences to order at approximately 1:30 p.m.

II. Findings of Fact

Consolidation of Dockets

4. The Prehearing Officer finds that ruling upon the consolidation of Commission dockets to which he is assigned is within the ambit of things the Prehearing Officer is allowed to rule upon.⁷ The Prehearing Officer further finds that at the October 15, 2019, prehearing conference, all parties agreed to consolidate these dockets. The Prehearing Officer further finds, for the sake of judicial efficiency, that it is in the public interest to consolidate Dockets 20-CONS-3043-CUIC and 20-CONS-3079-CUIC for hearing on a common record.⁸

Electronic Service

5. The Prehearing Officer finds that at the October 15, 2019, prehearing conference, all parties agreed to the electronic service of pleadings and orders for these consolidated dockets, under the same terms described in the September 11, 2019, *Prehearing Officer Order Regarding*

Electronic Service in Docket 20-CONS-3043-CUIC. The Prehearing Officer further finds that such

terms would be appropriate for this consolidated matter.

Procedural Schedule

6. The Prehearing Officer finds that at the October 15, 2019, prehearing conference, all

parties agreed to the following procedural schedule:

- 7. The Prehearing Officer also makes the following findings:
 - a. Any settlement agreement the parties wish to present for Commission consideration shall be due by December 9, 2019;
 - b. Failure to timely submit pre-filed testimony may result in the Commission restricting the right to testify and present evidence at the evidentiary hearing. At the hearing, the Commission may limit the parties' direct and rebuttal testimony to the pre-filed testimony; and
 - c. Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act should notify the Commission at least 10 days before the scheduled hearing date.

THEREFORE, THE PREHEARING OFFICER ORDERS:

A. The captioned dockets are consolidated. Each subsequent filing submitted for either of these consolidated dockets shall carry the caption of both dockets, and shall be filed only in Docket 20-CONS-3043-CUIC, which shall serve as the primary docket. Commission employees shall then then populate the filing in Docket 20-CONS-3079-CUIC.

B. Electronic service is authorized in this consolidated matter under the same terms described in the September 11, 2019, *Prehearing Officer Order Regarding Electronic Service* issued in Docket 20-CONS-3043-CUIC.

C. The procedural schedule set forth in Paragraphs 6 through 7 above is adopted and shall govern this consolidated proceeding.
