ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO ANSWER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. The Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. Jonathan A. Hammond filed a Complaint against Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) on March 30, 2012. The Commission initiated this docket and mailed the complaint to KCPL on or about April 19, 2012. Computing the time for filing a response to Jonathan A. Hammond's Complaint, KCPL calculates its Response is due April 30, 2012. The Commission has jurisdiction over this complaint under K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 66-104 and K.A.R. 82-1-220.

2. On April 30, 2012, KCPL filed a Motion asking for an extension of time of one week to file its Response to Jonathan A. Hammond's Complaint. In its Motion, KCPL noted that its counsel had been out of town on company business and returned to the office on April 30, 2012. KCPL further notes that counsel for Commission Staff did not oppose KCPL's Motion.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:**

(A) The Commission grants KCPL's Motion for Extension of Time to Answer and extends KCPL's deadline to respond to May 7, 2012.


(B) This Order will be served using United States mail or hand-delivery. Parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).

(A) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary and proper.
