**APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND
AUTHORITY TO TRANSACT THE BUSINESS OF AN ELECTRIC PUBLIC UTILITY**

COMES NOW Evergy Kansas Central Inc. d/b/a Evergy Kansas Central (“Evergy Kansas Central”), and in support of its Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Authority, states:

1. Evergy Kansas Central is a Kansas corporation authorized by the Commission to conduct the business of a public utility under the provisions of K.S.A. 66-104, and as such holds a Certificate of Convenience and Authority from this Commission to engage in the business of an electric public utility in the State of Kansas, thereby promoting the public convenience. Evergy Kansas Central seeks to serve, subject to the Commission’s approval, in the city of St. Marys (“St. Marys”) certified territory described below:

POTTAWATOMIE COUNTY, KANSAS

A tract of land with a territory legal description of beg NW Cor Wildwood Terr
Add R PLT TH SW464,' NW385.32', SW232. 35', NW38', NE177.02',
NW92.18', N E85.65', NE195.52', E535' TO POB of Section 03, Township 10
South, and Range 12 East of Pottawatomie County, Kansas. See Exhibit A.

2. Evergy Kansas Central’s certified territory is adjacent to the territory described in paragraph 1.

3. In order for St. Marys to serve the customer, they would have to run service conductor a considerable length from a meter pole near the city limits to the house costing the

customer a considerable amount of money. Evergy Kansas Central has a closer and less expensive path to set up service for the customer.

4. Evergy Kansas Central and St. Marys have mutually agreed, subject to the Commission's approval, that Evergy Kansas Central should serve as an electric public utility in the territory described in paragraph 1.

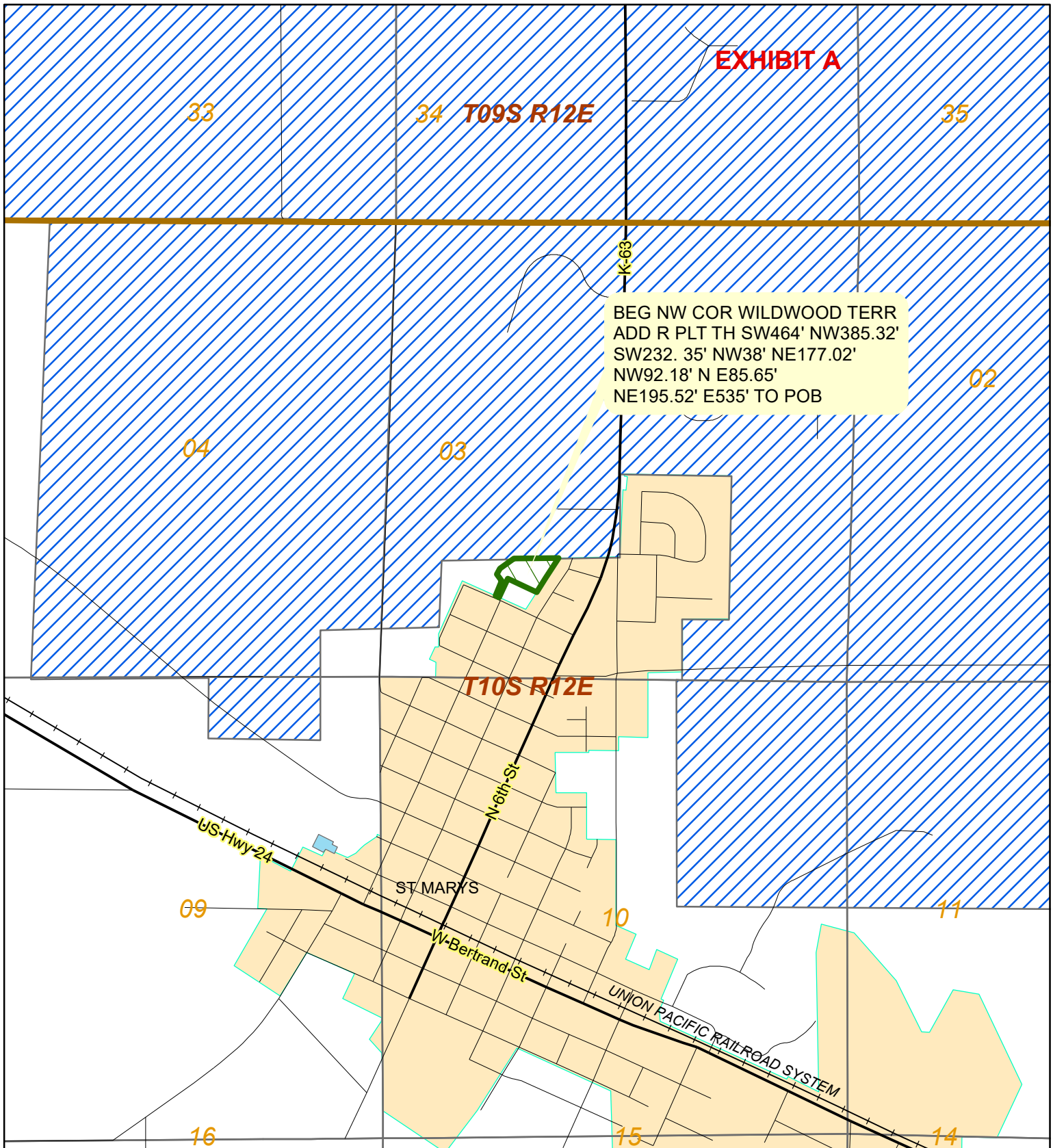
