**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF PROTEST**

Bayshore Energy KS LLC ("Bayshore") herein submits its intention to withdraw its protest regarding Berexco LLC's ("Berexco") application for a second exception to the 10-year time limitation of K.A.R. 82-3-111 regarding the Garden City A #4-29 well.

On April 28, 2017, Berexco, as Operator, filed an Application for an "additional exception to the 10-year limitation, specifically to allow the subject well to remain eligible for temporary abandonment status for the three (3) years following the April 29, 2017, expiration of the first exception to the 10-year limitation, subject to yearly renewal with the appropriate Conservation Division District, but without further need to re-apply for a new exception each of the three (3) years prayed for in [its] application (the "Application")."


Subsequently, on May 22, 2017, the Commission Conservation Division, Legal Section, received a letter of protest from Bayshore.
