**ORDER REINSTATING MOTOR CARRIER OPERATING AUTHORITY**

The above-captioned matter comes on for consideration and determination by the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (“Commission”) for consideration and determination upon its own motion. Having examined its files and records, the Commission, finds and concludes:

**I.      Legal Standards**

1.      Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,108b, 66-1,111, 66-1,112, 66-1,114, 66-1,114b and 66-1,115, and amendments thereto, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in K.A.R. 82-4-3f, doing business or procuring business in Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority, and jurisdiction.

2.      Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130, and 66-1,142b, and amendments thereto, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke, or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in

regard to the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision, or regulation of the Commission.

3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129(a)(7), the Commission has adopted motor carrier transportation regulations (K.A.R. 82-4-3f) consistent with the federal motor carrier safety assistance program and other federal requirements concerning transportation of hazardous waste.

## **II. Analysis**

4. SPF Logistics LLC is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5 as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f that operates commercial motor vehicle(s) in both intrastate and interstate commerce in a manner that requires authority.

5. SPF Logistics LLC is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and operates under USDOT Number 4118326.

6. The Commission received notice from the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration that SPF Logistics LLC's New Entrant Registration had been revoked effective August 30, 2024, for failure to comply with safety requirements.

7. Pursuant to the above authority, on September 10, 2024, the Commission entered an Emergency Suspension of Operating Authority Order on SPF Logistics LLC in the above-referenced docket, until such time that Staff recommended reinstatement.

8. On October 25, 2024, the Staff of the Transportation Division of the Kansas Corporation Commission (Staff) received notice from the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, that SPF Logistics LLC has submitted evidence of compliance with safety requirements as required in 49 C.F.R. 385.329. As a result, the carrier's reapplication for New Entrant registration under USDOT No. 4118326 has been approved and the

carrier's authority to operate in interstate operations has been reinstated. See attached FMCSA reinstatement documentation, a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment "A" and is hereby incorporated by reference.

9. Carrier further submitted evidence of attendance at a Kansas Corporation Commission-sponsored safety seminar. Staff confirmed a representative of Carrier attended on October 6, 2025.

10. The Commission finds it has jurisdiction over SPF Logistics LLC because it is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5 as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f.

11. The Commission finds that by attending a Commission-sponsored safety seminar, SPF Logistics LLC has met the requirements of the September 10, 2024, Emergency Suspension of Operating Authority Order.

12. Based on the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's reinstatement, the Commission concludes it should reinstate SPF Logistics LLC's motor carrier operations in Kansas.

**THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:**

A. SPF Logistics LLC's intrastate motor carrier operations in Kansas are hereby reinstated.

**Action Required: Call to schedule a Safety Audit.**

According to Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's (FMCSA) records thirty days have elapsed since SPF LOGISTICS LLC's USDOT New Entrant registration was revoked on August 30, 2024, and that SPF LOGISTICS LLC has reapplied in accordance with 49 CFR 385.329. This is to inform SPF LOGISTICS LLC that SPF LOGISTICS LLC's reapplication for USDOT New Entrant registration has been approved.

A safety audit has not yet been conducted; SPF LOGISTICS LLC should contact your local State Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Program (MCSAP) office 785-296-8533 as soon as possible to schedule a safety audit. In accordance with 49 CFR section 385.337, failure to permit a safety audit to be performed may result in the revocation of SPF LOGISTICS LLC's USDOT New Entrant registration and SPF LOGISTICS LLC's interstate operation being placed out of service. Additionally, the refusal to submit to a safety audit may also subject a new entrant motor carrier to the penalty provisions in 49 U.S.C. 521(b) (2) (A), as adjusted by inflation.

SPF LOGISTICS LLC's 18-month new entrant safety monitoring period restarts as of October 25, 2024. FMCSA will continue to monitor and evaluate SPF LOGISTICS LLC's safety management practices and on-road performance to ensure SPF LOGISTICS LLC has basic safety management controls that are operating effectively and is complying with Federal requirements including the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs) and applicable Federal Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMRs). Failure to comply with applicable requirements may result in the revocation of SPF LOGISTICS LLC's USDOT New Entrant or permanent registration.

SPF LOGISTICS LLC's USDOT number can be found in the upper right hand corner of this letter. This USDOT number should be marked on commercial motor vehicles operated by SPF LOGISTICS LLC as required by 49 CFR section 390.21. A copy of the FMCSRs, including this regulation, may be found on the FMCSA web site, <http://safer.fmcsa.dot.gov>.
