PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE ORDER

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records and being duly advised on the premises, the Commission finds as follows:

1. On May 18, 2004, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) filed its application in this docket.
2. The Commission has determined that a pre-hearing conference is necessary to ascertain the status of this proceeding, to discuss discovery procedures, to establish a workshop schedule and/or procedural schedule and to consider any other matters that may promote the orderly and prompt conduct of this proceeding. K.A.R. 82-1-222 and K.S.A. 77-517.
3. A pre-hearing conference will be held on Friday, June 25, 2004, at 9:00 a.m., in the Third Floor Hearing Room at the Commission's offices in Topeka, Kansas. Pursuant to K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 77-514 and K.S.A. 77-516, the Commission directs that Susan Cunningham serve as presiding officer at the pre-hearing conference.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

(A) A pre-hearing conference will be held on June 25, 2004, at 9:00 a.m., in the Commission's Third Floor Hearing Room, 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas. The Commission directs that the hearing examiner be Susan Cunningham of the same address, (785) 271-3110. The attorney who has been designated to appear for the agency in this matter is Wendy Tatro, Assistant General Counsel of the same address, (785) 271-3119. Any party who fails to attend or participate in the pre-hearing conference or in any other stage of this proceeding may be held in default. K.S.A. 77-516(c)(8) and K.S.A. 77-520. At the pre-hearing conference, this proceeding, without further notice, may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter. K.S.A. 77-516(c)(7).

(B) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.

(C) A party may file a petition for reconsideration of this order within fifteen (15) days of the date of this order. If service is by mail, three (3) additional days may be added to the fifteen (15) day time limit.
