ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

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The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas. Having examined the files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On October 21, 2014, the Commission issued its Order to Show Cause,

Designating a Prehearing Officer, and Setting a Prehearing Conference.

- 2. On March 19, 2015, Red Cloud appeared before the Commission at a scheduled evidentiary hearing. The Commission continued the hearing with the understanding that Red Cloud intended to file a well transfer form taking responsibility for the subject wells.
- 3. On March 30, 2015, Staff moved the Commission to close this docket. The motion stated that on March 27, 2015, Red Cloud filed a well transfer form taking responsibility for the subject wells, and that a hearing was no longer needed. No response was filed. Counsel for Red Cloud has informed the parties that Red Cloud is not opposed to the motion.

4. The Commission finds and concludes that this docket should be closed as complete based on Staff's recommendation. Staff's pending motions for a default order and for summary judgment are denied as moot.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. This docket is hereby closed, and Staff's pending motions for a default order and for summary judgment are denied as moot.

B. Any party affected by this Order may file with the Commission a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529(a). The petition shall be filed within 15 days after service of this Order. If service of this Order is by mail, three days are added to the deadline. The petition shall be addressed to the Commission and sent to 266 N. Main, Ste. 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202. Pursuant to K.S.A. 55-606 and K.S.A. 77-529(a), reconsideration is prerequisite for judicial review of this Order. Any party taking an action permitted by this summary proceeding before the deadline for a petition for reconsideration does so at their own risk of further proceedings.

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction of the subject matter and the parties and may enter additional orders as it deems appropriate.
