MOTION FOR PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L” or the “Company”) and requests that the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (“Commission” or “KCC”) establish the procedural schedule in this matter. In support of this Motion, KCP&L states:

1. Simultaneously with the filing of this Motion, KCP&L has submitted a rate case application and supporting testimony.
2. As part of the Stipulation and Agreement filed on June 18, 2009 in Docket No. 09-KCPE-246-RTS (the “246 Stipulation” and “246 Docket” respectively), KCP&L, the Staff of the Commission (“Staff”), the Citizens’ Utility Ratepayer Board (“CURB”), and Kansas Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. (“KEPCo”) agreed that they would collaborate prior to the current case to develop a procedural schedule to avoid the timing and procedural problems that arose during the 246 Docket.
3. In the Commission’s July 24, 2009 Order issued in the 246 Docket (“246 Order”) the Commission accepted this aspect of the 246 Stipulation.
4. On September 9, 2009, in Docket No. 04-KCPE-1025-GIE (the “1025 Docket”), the following parties filed their *Joint Report Regarding the Timing and Process for Kansas City Power & Light Company’s Final Rate Proceeding Under its Five-Year Regulatory Plan* (“Joint

Report”): KCP&L; Staff; CURB; KEPCo; and Danisco USA, Inc. (“Danisco”), Amcor Pet Packaging USA, Inc., (“Amcor”), Shawnee Mission School District No. 512 (“USD 512”), the City of Mission, Kansas (“Mission”), and Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. (“Wal-Mart”) (collectively, the Midwest Utilities Users Group (“MUUG”) (and all parties, collectively, the “Signatories to the Joint Report”).

5. The Signatories to the Joint Report agreed upon a relational procedural schedule for the 2010 rate case that is expected to address the timing problems discovered during the 246 Docket. The agreed upon schedule was attached to the Joint Report as Attachment A.

6. As noted in the Joint Report, the procedural schedule contained in Attachment A to the Joint Report included a “plug-in” filing date that would change as KCP&L obtained more information regarding the date by which Iatan Unit 2 is expected to go in-service. The other dates in the procedural schedule would then correspondingly change in accordance with the actual filing date, adjusted as necessary for holidays, weekends and other conflicts, but will generally maintain the relationships shown in the Attachment A to the Joint Report.

7. Based on KCP&L filing this rate case on December 17, 2009, KCP&L has made corresponding adjustments to the dates contained in Attachment A to the Joint Report, attached hereto as **Attachment A**, and proposes the following procedural schedule:

8. As noted in the Joint Report, there is also a need for flexibility in the procedural schedule due to the exact in-service date of Iatan Unit 2. The Signatories to Joint Report agreed on the following issues, which are hereby incorporated by reference: (1) the process whereby the remaining schedule may be adjusted if the in-service date of Iatan Unit 2 is expected to move beyond the timeframe anticipated within the original procedural schedule; (2) the process whereby the required date for the Commission's Order (and the date by which rates are to become effective) is extended if hearings have concluded before knowledge of a change in the in-service date; and (3) the process to address a dispute regarding the in-service date for Iatan Unit 2.

WHEREFORE, KCP&L respectfully requests the Commission grant this Motion and issue an Order adopting the above listed procedural schedule.



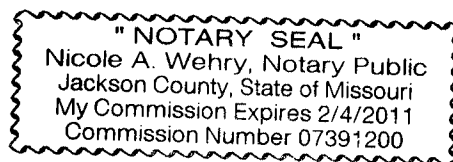
