ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the following:

1. On October 29, 2018, Redbud Oil & Gas Operating, LLC (Operator) filed an Application to authorize injection of natural gas into the Cattleman formation at the Westfall #2E-12 well, located in Montgomery County, Kansas.¹
2. On November 20, 2018, Arlyn Hare, Director, Eagle Oak Land Development, filed a letter protesting the Application.² On November 29, 2018, Arlyn Hare also requested a hearing.³
3. On December 20, 2018, the Commission issued an *Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference*, scheduling a Prehearing Conference for January 10, 2019.⁴

4. A Prehearing Conference was held on January 10, 2019, at which the following procedural schedule was proposed:

Operator Pre-filed Direct Testimony	Due: March 4, 2019
Protestant Pre-Filed Direct Testimony	Due: March 18, 2019
Staff Pre-Filed Direct Testimony	Due: April 1, 2019
Rebuttal Testimony	Due: April 8, 2019
<u>Evidentiary Hearing before the Commission</u>	April 18, 2019, 10:00 a.m.

5. Failure to submit pre-filed testimony may result in the Commission restricting the right to testify and present evidence at the evidentiary hearing. At the hearing, the Commission may limit the parties' direct and rebuttal testimony to the pre-filed testimony.

6. Any settlement agreement the parties wish to present for Commission consideration shall be due by April 1, 2019.

7. Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) should notify the Commission at least 10 days before the scheduled hearing date.

8. Any party who fails to attend or participate in the evidentiary hearing or in any other stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.⁵

9. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.⁶

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. The procedural schedule set forth in paragraph 4 above is adopted.

B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).⁷

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
