MOTION TO AMEND APPLICATION

Town Oil Company, Inc., ("Applicant"), by and through its counsel, Jeffrey A. Wilson, Anderson & Byrd, LLP, hereby moves the Kansas Corporation Commission ("Commission") for leave to amend its application, which amended application is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A." In support of its Motion, Applicant states:

- Applicant filed an application with the Commission on August 28, 2014, seeking a permit
 to inject saltwater into the Squirrel formation for the Applicant's wells on the Savage
 Lease, specifically wells #1-W, #2-W, #3W, #5W, and #6W, located in the NW/4 of
 Section 5, Township 18 South, Range 21 East, Franklin County, Kansas. Said application
 requested a maximum injection pressure of 100 psig.
- 2. The application contained a typographical error requesting 100 psig when, in reality,

 Applicant meant to request a maximum pressure of 400 psig. Therefore, the Applicant
 seeks leave to amend its original application so that the amended application reflects the
 correct pressure requested.
- 3. Notice of the original application was given to all parties listed in K.A.R. 82-3-135b(c).

- 4. Notice of the original application was published on August 14, 2014 in the Ottawa Herald, the official newspaper for Franklin County, Kansas. Said notice is included with Applicant's original application. Said notice stated the correct requested pressure, 400 psig. Therefore, a new notice publication should not be required as the original published notice was sufficient to advise any potential interested parties of the nature and extent of Applicant's application, as amended.
- 5. Upon basis of the above and foregoing, Applicant believes that no additional notice of this motion to amend the application is required and that the motion and the amended application may be granted without the notices contained in K.A.R. 82-3-135a and K.A.R. 82-3-402.

WHEREFORE, Applicant seeks leave from the Commission to file the amended application which is attached to this motion as Exhibit "A;" a preliminary ruling that notice of this application has been given in compliance with the rules, regulations, and laws governing this matter; and that an order be entered granting the amended application filed herein.
