This letter is to inform you that your challenge concerning violation(s) **392.3** – **Operating a CMV while ill or fatigued**, has been **DENIED**. Please see guidance below

- §392.3 III or fatigued operator.
  - No driver shall operate a commercial motor vehicle, and a motor carrier shall not require or permit a driver to operate a commercial motor vehicle, while the driver's ability or alertness is so impaired, or so likely to become impaired, through fatigue, illness, or any other cause, as to make it unsafe for him/her to begin or continue to operate the commercial motor vehicle...
- Are carriers liable for the actions of their employees?
  - Yes. Carriers are liable for the actions of their employees, neither intent to commit, nor actual knowledge of, a violation is a necessary element of that liability.


