## <u>ORDER</u>

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On October 9, 2002, Southwestern Bell Telephone L.P. d/b/a SBC Kansas (SBC), formerly Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, filed an application seeking approval of the Interconnection Agreement (Agreement) between SBC and Sprint Communications Company, L.P. (Sprint). On November 12, 2002, the Commission concurrently approved the Agreement and a modification thereto.

2. On October 12, 2004, SBC filed an application seeking approval of a modification to the Agreement between SBC and Sprint. The proposed modification adds a Collocation Power amendment which establishes an agreed methodology for charging of collocation DC Power. The Commission previously approved this amendment in Docket No. 01-SWBT-446-IAT.

3. The parties believe approval of the modification to the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not discriminate against any

telecommunications carrier. Staff believes the public will generally benefit from Commission approval of the Agreement.

4. Sprint is registered with the office of the Kansas Secretary of State and currently has an "active and in good standing" status.

5. The Commission finds and concludes that the application for modification to the Interconnection Agreement between SWBT and Sprint should be approved. The Agreement, as modified, is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. The modification to the Interconnection Agreement between Southwestern Bell Telephone L.P. d/b/a SBC Kansas and Sprint Communications Company, L.P. is hereby approved.

B. Any party may file a petition for reconsideration of this order within fifteen days of the date this order is served. If service is by mail, service is complete upon mailing and three days may be added to the above time frame.

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
