BACKGROUND:

On September 9, 2011, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Kansas (AT&T) filed an Application for approval of an Interconnection Agreement with Sonic Telecom, LLC (Sonic).

1996 With Sonic Telecom, LLC

AT&T contends that implementation of this Agreement complies fully with Section 252(e) of the Federal Act. AT&T believes approval is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier.

AT&T presents this Agreement and its attachments as an integrated package, the result of negotiations and compromise. AT&T states there are no outstanding issues between the parties that need the assistance of mediation or arbitration.

ANALYSIS:

Sonic is properly registered with the Kansas Secretary of State's office and is currently "active and in good standing" with the Secretary's office. Sonic was granted authority to operate in the

state of Kansas as a competitive local exchange carrier in Docket No. 11-STLT-681-COC on May 9, 2011.

Section 252(e) of the Federal Act states that state commissions may reject a negotiated agreement only if it finds that the agreement (or portions thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or the implementation of such an agreement (or portions thereof) is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Staff has reviewed the Agreement and finds no such cause for concern from this filing.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends Commission approval of the negotiated Agreement.
