ORDER GRANTING MCC APPLICATION FOR KANSAS VIDEO SERVICE AUTHORIZATION

The above-captioned matter comes on before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having reviewed its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission grants the Application of MCC Missouri LLC d/b/a Mediacom (MCC) for Kansas Video Service Authorization (Application).

- 1. MCC filed its Application on December 30, 2010.
- 2. Commission staff (Staff) provided its Report and Recommendation (Report) on January 10, 2011, analyzing the Application. Staff's Report was posted on the Commission's web site that same day to provide interested persons with the opportunity to comment on the Application. No public comments were received.
- 3. In its Report, Staff advised the Commission that MCC had identified its principal place of business as 100 Crystal Run Road, Middletown, New York, 10941. MCC also identified its principal officers, including the MCC representative who tends to regulatory contact and point of contact for consumer complaint matters.

- 4. Staff reported that MCC was registered with the Kansas Secretary of State's office as a Foreign Limited Liability entity and was "active and in good standing" with that office.
- 5. MCC is requesting the Kansas video service authorization in order to serve Eureka, Galena, Scranton, Baldwin and Oswego. MCC advised Staff that it currently serves the five municipalities with service that fully covers the foot prints for which MCC seeks state video service authority. MCC provided a rough legal description of the four cities as reflected in Staff's Report. MCC also provided a high level sketch and a general description of the architecture and components used in providing its video service.
- 6. Staff reported that MCC has agreed to comply with all applicable federal and state statutes and regulations. MCC further agreed to comply with all lawful and applicable municipal regulations regarding the use and occupation of public rights-of-way in the delivery of video services, including the police powers of the municipalities in which the service is delivered. Further, MCC agreed not to deny its services to potential customers based on the average population income.
- 7. Staff also reported that it had confirmed MCC's Community Unit Identification numbers with the Federal Communications Commission.
 - 8. Staff recommended that the Commission grant the Application.
- 9. The Commission has reviewed Staff's Report and concludes that it should grant the Application.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. The Commission grants the Application of MCC Missouri LLC for Kansas Video Service Authorization to provide video service in the municipalities of Eureka, Galena, Scranton, Baldwin and Oswego.

B. The Commission retains jurisdiction over MCC and the subject matter of this docket for the purpose of issuing such additional orders it deems necessary.
