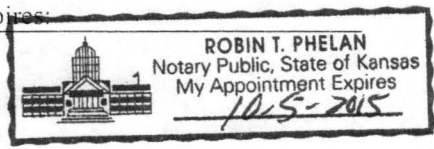

ALL PRODUCERS AND PURCHASERS OF NATURAL GAS IN SAID GAS FIELDS, AND TO ALL ROYALTY OWNERS, LANDOWNERS, AND ALL OTHER CONCERNED PERSONS:

Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-3-135a(e), the above-referenced matter has been set for hearing. The hearing will be held on April 19, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the same may be reached, at the Commission's Hearing Room, 130 S. Market, Room 2078, Wichita, Kansas 67202.

The purpose of this hearing is to allow those parties in interest to show cause why the above-referenced Basic Proration Order should not be dissolved. The hearing will be formal in nature and will involve both the rules of civil procedure and the rules of evidence. Please note the K.A.R. 82-1-228(d)(2) requires that corporations appear through an attorney. Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-229, Intervenor and Protestants, if any, must prefile direct testimony ten (10) days prior to the date of the hearing. Rebuttal testimony may be presented at the hearing. If you fail to appear at the hearing or prefile testimony, the commission may proceed to hear evidence against you and enter such order as shall be justified by the evidence.

Any person required special accommodations under The Americans With Disabilities Act need to give notice to the commission at least ten (10) days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
