MOTION TO RESCIND PENALTY ORDER

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Staff" and "Commission," respectively) files this Motion, asking that the Commission's September 28, 2017, Penalty Order by rescinded. In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. On September 28, 2017, the Commission issued a Penalty Order against Butler Bros., Inc. ("Applicant"), due to an unplugged well remaining on it expired license. Operator's license had expired August 30, 2017, and Staff had sent a Notice of Violation letter September 5, 2017, giving Operator a September 19, 2017, deadline to obtain compliance to avoid a penalty The Penalty Order was issued based upon Staff's September 25, 2017 penalty recommendation.
- 2. On October 18, 2017, Operator timely requested a hearing. Upon review, Staff has determined that Operator submitted a Transfer of Operator ("T-1") Form September 15, 2017, transferring the only well on its license to another operator, but that the form had not been processed by Staff at the time of the penalty recommendation.
- 3. While technically a violation of K.A.R. 82-3-120 occurred, it is not Staff's policy to recommend a penalty when the operator has done everything necessary to remedy the violation prior to the deadline in Staff's Notice of Violation letter. If Staff had realized that the T-1 had been submitted, it would not have recommended the penalty.

WHEREFORE, Staff moves the Commission to rescind its September 28, 2017, Penalty Order.
