

application requesting the proposed change. If the commission does not suspend the proposed schedule within 30 days of the date the same is filed by the public utility or common carrier, such proposed schedule shall be deemed approved by the commission and shall take effect on the proposed effective date.”

4. A full investigation of Blue Valley’s request, which may result in a hearing, is deemed necessary and proper. Absent suspension of Blue Valley’s request, Commission Staff is without sufficient time to fully review, consider, and analyze whether the requested KUSF support increase should be approved.

5. The Commission finds and concludes that suspension of any potential effectiveness Blue Valley’s request is required to allow sufficient time for full investigation of this matter. The effective date of proposed request shall be suspended for a period not to exceed 240 days from the date the Application was made, November 8, 2019, until July 6, 2020. A Commission decision may be issued before such date.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. Any decision regarding Blue Valley’s Application shall be deferred until July 6, 2020. The Commission may issue a decision before such date.


B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of issuing such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
