**ENTRY OF APPEARANCE**

Pursuant to the 34.5kV formula based ratemaking (“FBR”) protocols approved by the State  
Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (“Commission”) for Western Cooperative  
Electric Association, Inc. (“Western”) in Docket No. 21-SEPE-049-TAR (“21-049 Docket”) (the  
“Western 34.5kV FBR Protocols”), “Entities granted intervention in 21-SEPE-049-TAR who  
either are or represent customers of Western at the time of the Annual Update filing will be
