*JOINT MOTION REQUESTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE
AND ISSUANCE OF A PROTECTIVE ORDER*

COME NOW the Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Staff"), the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board ("CURB"), and the Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") (collectively, "Joint Movants") and file this joint motion for an order of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") adopting a procedural schedule and issuing a protective order in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of this motion, Joint Movants state as follows:

1. On March 30, 2012, KCP&L filed an Application seeking Commission approval of KCP&L's 2012 Energy Efficiency Rider ("EE Rider"), to recover costs incurred January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 ("2011 Program Costs"). KCP&L's filing follows the process set out in the Joint Stipulation and Agreement reached in Docket No. 07-KCPE-905-RTS ("905 S&A") and approved by the Commission in its November 20, 2007 Order in that docket.

2. On April 4, 2012, CURB filed a Petition to Intervene in the above captioned proceeding, which is still pending. To date, no other parties have filed for intervention in this docket.

3. The 905 S&A established March 31 as the deadline for KCP&L to file its annual EE Rider, and adopted July 1 as the annual implementation date; however, no

definitive schedule for the filing of Staff's report and recommendation, intervener comments, or issuance of a Commission order was included in the 905 S&A. Joint Movants recommend the following procedural schedule be established in this proceeding:

- Staff's Report and Recommendation shall be filed on or before 3:00 p.m., May 21, 2012.
- Comments by CURB and any other intervening party shall be filed on or before 3:00 p.m., June 4, 2012.
- Any final response by KCP&L shall be filed on or before 3:00 p.m., June 11, 2012.
- A Commission order shall be issued on or before June 27, 2012.

4. In its Application, KCP&L requested that the Commission issue an order in this proceeding no later than June 22, 2012 so that the new EE Rider could be implemented by the July 1, 2012 effective date. Because of the timing of weekends on this 2012 schedule, and the attempt to provide all parties roughly the same amount of time for responding that was set in KCP&L's EE Rider docket last year, Docket No. 11-KCPE-665-TAR, KCP&L is willing to adjust its requested order date from June 22, 2012 to on or before June 27, 2012. Although this leaves KCP&L with just three days to implement the EE Rider, KCP&L believes it can meet the July 1 implementation date with an order issued on or before June 27, 2012 in this docket.


5. In addition, Joint Movants request the Commission issue a standard protective order in this docket to govern the exchange of confidential information between the parties in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Staff, CURB, and KCP&L jointly request this Commission approve the proposed procedural schedule as set forth above, and issue a standard protective order to govern the exchange of confidential information in this docket.




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
