4. No other party is able to represent the interests' of AARP in this matter.





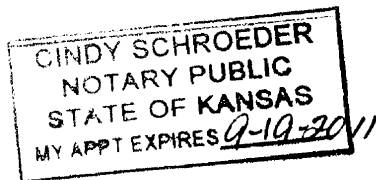
