

3. On January 30, 2015, in the 297 Docket, ONEOK NGL filed its Amendment to Application for Approval of ONEOK NGL Pipeline, LLC KCC Tariff 9.1, to include references that were inadvertently omitted from its original Application.

4. On January 30, 2015, in the 329 Docket, ONEOK NGL filed its Application to Amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Transact the Business of a Liquid Pipeline Common Carrier. ONEOK NGL specifically stated that “[i]n order to add the new route related to the tariff rate applied for in the 297 Docket, ONEOK NGL is requesting to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity in this application.”¹ Under K.S.A. 66-131 the Commission has 180 days to issue an Order on the certificate of convenience.

5. On February 5, 2015, Staff filed its Motion to Consolidate requesting that Docket No. 15-ONEP-297-TAR and Docket No. 15-ONEP-329-COC be consolidated and placed under the same final order deadline. Staff explained that ONEOK NGL’s request for a Certificate of Convenience and an Application requesting approval to establish a new route and set a rate for that route are intrinsically linked and should have originally been filed together. Otherwise, the Commission could find itself in a situation in which it would have to issue an order on the expansion of ONEOK NGL’s certificate prior to making the determination on the requested route and rate.

6. ONEOK NGL did not object to Staff’s Motion to Consolidate.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. Docket No. 15-ONEP-297-TAR and Docket No. 15-ONEP-329-COC be consolidated and placed under the same final order deadline.


B. The parties have 15 days, plus three days if service of this Order is by mail, to petition the Commission for reconsideration.²
