C. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.<sup>4</sup>

D. Parties have 15 days from the date of electronic service of this Order to petition for reconsideration.<sup>5</sup>

E. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
